A BILL FOR

- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{1}}$ An Act relating to disaster recovery case management.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.F. 2268

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 29C.20B Disaster case management.
- The rebuild Iowa office shall work with the department
- 3 of human services and nonprofit, voluntary, and faith-based
- 4 organizations active in disaster recovery and response
- 5 in coordination with the homeland security and emergency
- 6 management division to establish a statewide system of disaster
- 7 case management to be activated following the governor's
- 8 proclamation of a disaster emergency or the declaration
- 9 of a major disaster by the president of the United States
- 10 for individual assistance purposes. Under the system, the
- 11 department of human services shall coordinate case management
- 12 services locally through local committees as established in
- 13 each local emergency management commission's emergency plan.
- 14 Beginning July 1, 2011, the department of human services
- 15 shall assume the duties of the rebuild Iowa office under this
- 16 subsection.
- 17 2. The department of human services, in conjunction with
- 18 the rebuild Iowa office, the homeland security and emergency
- 19 management division, and an Iowa representative to the national
- 20 voluntary organizations active in disaster, shall adopt rules
- 21 pursuant to chapter 17A to create coordination mechanisms
- 22 and standards for the establishment and implementation of
- 23 a statewide system of disaster case management which shall
- 24 include at least all of the following:
- 25 a. Disaster case management standards.
- 26 b. Disaster case management policies.
- 27 c. Reporting requirements.
- 28 d. Eligibility criteria.
- 29 e. Coordination mechanisms necessary to carry out the
- 30 services provided.
- 31 f. Develop formal working relationships with agencies and
- 32 create interagency agreements for those considered to provide
- 33 disaster case management services.
- 34 q. Coordination of all available services for individuals
- 35 from multiple agencies.

- 1 Sec. 2. BUSINESS DISASTER CASE MANAGEMENT TASK FORCE.
- A business disaster case management task force is
- 3 established to research disaster recovery case management
- 4 assistance needed for businesses following a major disaster.
- 5 The task force shall recommend steps for preparing to provide
- 6 such assistance following disasters.
- 7 2. The task force shall consult with experts, businesses
- 8 impacted by previous disasters, and other interested
- 9 stakeholders.
- 10 3. The task force shall submit written recommendations to
- 11 the governor and the general assembly by November 15, 2010.
- 12 4. The rebuild Iowa office shall provide staffing for the
- 13 task force.
- 14 5. The task force shall consist of the following members
- 15 appointed by the governor:
- 16 a. A representative of the United States small business
- 17 administration.
- 18 b. A representative of Iowa small business development
- 19 centers.
- 20 c. A representative of the safeguard Iowa partnership.
- 21 d. A representative of professional developers of Iowa.
- 22 e. A representative of the Iowa association of business and
- 23 industry.
- 24 f. A representative of the Iowa retail federation.
- 25 g. A representative of the department of economic
- 26 development.
- 27 h. A representative of the homeland security and emergency
- 28 management division of the department of public defense.
- 29 i. Two business owners.
- 30 j. A representative of the Iowa association of regional
- 31 councils.
- 32 k. A representative of the Iowa emergency management
- 33 association.
- 34 6. Four ex officio, nonvoting members, two from each chamber
- 35 of the general assembly, shall be appointed, with no more than

- 1 one appointed from the same political party from each chamber.
- 2 The majority leader of the senate, the minority leader of the
- 3 senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the
- 4 minority leader of the house of representatives shall each
- 5 appoint one legislative member. The members appointed under
- 6 this subsection shall not be eligible for per diem and expenses
- 7 as provided in section 2.10.
- 8 7. Members of the task force shall not receive a per diem,
- 9 shall not be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses while
- 10 in attendance at any meeting, and shall not be reimbursed for
- 11 travel expenses.
- 12 8. The task force may conduct meetings telephonically.
- 13 EXPLANATION
- 14 This bill relates to disaster recovery case management.
- 15 The bill requires the rebuild Iowa office to work with
- 16 the department of human services and nonprofit, voluntary,
- 17 and faith-based organizations active in disaster recovery
- 18 and response in coordination with the homeland security
- 19 and emergency management division of the department of
- 20 public defense to establish a statewide system of disaster
- 21 case management to be activated following the governor's
- 22 proclamation of a disaster emergency or the declaration of
- 23 a major disaster by the president of the United States for
- 24 individual assistance purposes. The department is required
- 25 to coordinate case management services locally through local
- 26 committees as established in each local emergency management
- 27 commission's emergency plan. Beginning July 1, 2011, the
- 28 department of human services shall assume the duties of the
- 29 rebuild Iowa office.
- 30 The bill creates a business disaster case management task
- 31 force to research disaster recovery case management assistance
- 32 needed for businesses following a major disaster. The task
- 33 force shall recommend steps for preparing to provide such
- 34 assistance following disasters by November 15, 2010. The
- 35 rebuild Iowa office shall provide staffing for the task force.
