SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 115 BY COURTNEY

1 A Resolution requesting the legislative council to act in support of the Iowa board of pharmacy contracting 2 to convene a task force on medical marijuana. 3 WHEREAS, the board of pharmacy performed a careful 4 5 evaluation and held hearings around the state in 2009 6 prior to developing a recommendation regarding the 7 usage of marijuana for medicinal purposes; and WHEREAS, in February 2010 the board of pharmacy 8 9 unanimously recommended reclassifying the drug to 10 allow its use for pain, nausea, and other symptoms from 11 diseases such as cancer, acquired immune deficiency 12 syndrome (AIDS), and multiple sclerosis; and WHEREAS, the board of pharmacy recommended formation 13 14 of a task force to make recommendations regarding the 15 administration of a medical marijuana program; NOW 16 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, That the legislative 17 18 council is requested to act in support of the board 19 of pharmacy contracting to convene a task force on 20 medical marijuana to meet during the 2010 legislative 21 interim; and 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the task force be 23 charged to study and make recommendations regarding 24 reclassifying marijuana from schedule I of Iowa's

25 controlled substances law under Code chapter 124 into 26 schedule II of the law, and for implementation and 27 administration of a medical marijuana program; and 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the voting membership

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1 of the task force should include but not be limited to
2 all of the following:

3 1. A representative of a seriously ill patient.

4 2. A representative of law enforcement.

5 3. A representative of the attorney general.

6 4. A representative of a human immunodeficiency7 virus (HIV) organization or a physician caring for a8 patient with AIDS.

9 5. A representative of substance abuse treatment 10 providers.

11 6. A person who is living with a serious illness 12 or a representative of a hospice or palliative care 13 provider.

14 7. A representative of the Iowa board of nursing.
15 8. A representative of the Iowa board of medicine.
16 9. Two representatives of the Iowa board of
17 pharmacy.

18 10. A physician who is caring for a patient with 19 cancer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That, in addition to the voting membership, four legislative members from both political parties and both houses of the general assembly should be appointed to act as ex officio, nonvoting members of the task force; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the task force be directed to submit a report, including findings and recommendations, to the governor, general assembly, and board of pharmacy on or before December 15, 2010.

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
