The amendment in this Act to 1 14 section 68A.401 takes effect May 1, 2010. 1 15 EXPLANATION 1 16 Under current law, beginning in 2010 or 2012 according to 1 17 filings of statements of organization, a candidate's committee 1 18 of a candidate for statewide office or the general assembly 1 19 must file campaign finance statements and reports in an 1 20 electronic format by 4:30 p.m. of the day the filing is due. 1 21 This bill extends the requirement to include a state statutory 1 22 political committee, a political committee expressly 1 23 advocating for or against the nomination, election, or defeat 1 24 of a candidate for statewide office or the general assembly 1 25 and makes the requirement effective May 1, 2010. 1 26 LSB 1175DP 83 1 27 jr/rj/5
