Section 70A.1, Code 2009, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection: 1 3 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 10. Notwithstanding any provision of the 4 Code to the contrary, peace officers employed within the 5 department of public safety or the department of natural 6 resources who are not covered under a collective bargaining 7 agreement and who are required to work on a holiday as 8 described in section 1C.2, shall be provided compensatory time 9 off of one and one=half hours for each hour worked on a 1 10 holiday for a maximum of twelve hours of compensatory time 1 11 off. Compensatory time off provided pursuant to this 1 12 subsection may be used in one=hour increments. 1 13 EXPLANATION 1 14 This bill provides that peace officers within the 1 15 department of public safety and the department of natural 1 16 resources who are not covered by a collective bargaining

1 17 agreement and are required to work on a holiday shall be 1 18 granted compensatory time off of 1.5 hours per each hour 1 19 worked with a maximum of 12 hours. The bill further provides 1 20 that compensatory time off earned may be used in one=hour
