Section 423.3, Code 2009, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection: 1 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 40A. The sales price from the sale of 1 4 automotive refinish repair paint and other vehicle body 1 5 materials to a retailer to be used in providing a service that 1 6 is subject to section 423.2, subsection 6, if the service 7 provided includes the permanent application or use of the 8 paint and materials during a motor vehicle collision repair. EXPLANATION 1 10 This bill provides a state sales tax exemption for the 11 sales of automotive refinish repair paint and other vehicle 1 12 body materials to a retailer who will use the paint and 1 13 materials to provide a service that includes the permanent 1 14 application or consumption of the paint and materials for the 1 15 repair of a motor vehicle collision. The bill requires that 1 16 in order to qualify for the exemption, the retailer's services

1 17 must be subject to Code section 423.2, subsection 6, which 1 18 requires the retailer to charge sales tax on the automotive 1 19 services the retailer provides.
