- 14 1, 2010, and ending June 30, 2011. The bill also appropriates
- 15 moneys from the rebuild Iowa infrastructure fund to the
- 16 department for transfer to the Iowa finance authority for the
- 17 home ownership assistance program for military persons for the
- 18 same fiscal year.
