## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the criminal offense of intimidation with a
- 2 dangerous weapon or motor vehicle, and providing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 708.6, Code 2009, is amended by striking
- 2 the section and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 3 708.6 Intimidation with a dangerous weapon or motor vehicle.
- A person commits intimidation with a dangerous weapon
- 5 when the person shoots, throws, launches, or discharges a
- 6 dangerous weapon at, into, or in a building, vehicle, airplane,
- 7 railroad engine, railroad car, or boat, occupied by another
- 8 person, or within an assembly of people, and thereby places
- 9 the occupants or people in reasonable apprehension of serious
- 10 injury or threatens to commit such an act under circumstances
- ll raising a reasonable expectation that the threat will be
- 12 carried out.
- 2. A person commits intimidation with a motor vehicle
- 14 when the person drives a motor vehicle at or into a building,
- 15 vehicle, airplane, railroad engine, railroad car, or boat,
- 16 occupied by another person, or at or into an assembly
- 17 of people, and thereby places the occupants or people in
- 18 reasonable apprehension of serious injury or threatens to
- 19 commit such an act under circumstances raising a reasonable
- 20 expectation that the threat will be carried out.
- 21 3. a. A person who commits intimidation with a dangerous
- 22 weapon is guilty of a class "D" felony.
- 23 b. A person who commits intimidation with a motor vehicle is
- 24 guilty of a class "D" felony.
- 25 4. a. A person who commits intimidation with a dangerous
- 26 weapon with the intent to injure or provoke fear or anger in
- 27 another is quilty of a class "C" felony.
- 28 b. A person who commits intimidation with a motor vehicle
- 29 with the intent to injure or provoke fear or anger in another
- 30 is guilty of a class "C" felony.
- 31 EXPLANATION
- 32 This bill relates to the criminal offense of intimidation
- 33 with a dangerous weapon or motor vehicle.
- 34 The bill reorganizes Code section 708.6 and creates the
- 35 criminal offense of intimidation with a motor vehicle.

- 1 The bill does not modify the existing criminal offense of
- 2 intimidation with a dangerous weapon.
- 3 Under the bill, a person commits intimidation with a motor
- 4 vehicle if the person drives a motor vehicle at or into a
- 5 building, vehicle, airplane, railroad engine, railroad car, or
- 6 boat, occupied by another person, or at or into an assembly
- 7 of people, placing the occupants or people in reasonable
- 8 apprehension of serious injury or threatens to commit such an
- 9 act under circumstances raising a reasonable expectation that
- 10 the threat will be carried out.
- 11 A person who commits intimidation with a motor vehicle is
- 12 guilty of a class "D" felony.
- 13 A person who commits intimidation with a motor vehicle with
- 14 the intent to injure or provoke fear or anger in another is
- 15 guilty of a class "C" felony.
- 16 A class "D" felony is punishable by confinement for no more
- 17 than five years and a fine of at least \$750 but not more than
- 18 \$7,500. A class "C" felony is punishable by confinement for no
- 19 more than 10 years and a fine of at least \$1,000 but not more
- 20 than \$10,000.
