

**Senate Study Bill 3150 - Introduced**

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to providing false identification information  
2 to a peace officer, emergency medical care provider, or fire  
3 fighter and providing a penalty.  
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 719.1A Providing false  
2 identification information.

3 A person who knowingly provides false identification  
4 information to anyone known by the person to be a peace  
5 officer, emergency medical care provider under chapter 147A,  
6 or fire fighter, whether paid or volunteer, in the performance  
7 of any act which is within the scope of the lawful duty or  
8 authority of that officer, emergency medical care provider, or  
9 fire fighter, commits a simple misdemeanor.

10 Sec. 2. Section 805.3, Code 2009, is amended to read as  
11 follows:

12 **805.3 Procedure.**

13 Before the cited person is released, the person shall sign  
14 the citation, either in a paper or electronic format, under  
15 penalty of providing false identification information under  
16 section ~~719.3~~ 719.1A, properly identifying the person cited.  
17 The person's signature shall also serve as a written promise to  
18 appear in court at the time and place specified. A copy of the  
19 citation shall be given to the person.

20 Sec. 3. Section 805.6, subsection 1, paragraph a,  
21 subparagraph (2), Code Supplement 2009, is amended to read as  
22 follows:

23 (2) The uniform citation and complaint shall contain  
24 spaces for the parties' names; the address of the alleged  
25 offender; the registration number of the offender's vehicle;  
26 the information required by section 805.2, a warning which  
27 states, "I hereby swear and affirm that the information  
28 provided by me on this citation is true under penalty of  
29 providing false information"; and a statement that providing  
30 false identification information is a violation of section  
31 ~~719.3~~ 719.1A; a list of the scheduled fines prescribed by  
32 sections 805.8A, 805.8B, and 805.8C, either separately or by  
33 group, and a statement of the court costs payable in scheduled  
34 violation cases, whether or not a court appearance is required  
35 or is demanded; a brief explanation of sections 805.9 and

1 805.10; and a space where the defendant may sign an admission  
2 of the violation when permitted by section 805.9; and the  
3 uniform citation and complaint shall require that the defendant  
4 appear before a court at a specified time and place. The  
5 uniform citation and complaint also may contain a space for the  
6 imprint of a credit card, and may contain any other information  
7 which the commissioner of public safety, the director of  
8 transportation, and the director of the department of natural  
9 resources may determine.

EXPLANATION

11 This bill creates a new crime of providing false  
12 identification information and provides that a person who  
13 knowingly presents false identification information to anyone  
14 known by the person to be a peace officer, emergency medical  
15 care provider under Code chapter 147A, or fire fighter,  
16 whether paid or volunteer, in the performance of any act  
17 which is within the scope of the lawful duty or authority  
18 of that officer, emergency medical care provider, or fire  
19 fighter, commits a simple misdemeanor. A simple misdemeanor is  
20 punishable by confinement for no more than 30 days or a fine of  
21 at least \$65 but not more than \$625 or by both.

22 The bill makes conforming changes to procedural provisions  
23 relating to the issuance of citations in lieu of arrest under  
24 Code chapter 805.
