## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the criminal offense of simulated public
- 2 intoxication.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 123.46, subsection 2, Code 2009, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- A person shall not use or consume alcoholic liquor, wine,
- 4 or beer upon the public streets or highways. A person shall
- 5 not use or consume alcoholic liquor in any public place except
- 6 premises covered by a liquor control license. A person shall
- 7 not possess or consume alcoholic liquors, wine, or beer on
- 8 public school property or while attending a public or private
- 9 school-related function. A person shall not be intoxicated or
- 10 simulate intoxication in a public place. A person violating
- 11 this subsection is quilty of a simple misdemeanor.
- 12 Sec. 2. Section 123.46, Code 2009, is amended by adding the
- 13 following new subsection:
- 14 NEW SUBSECTION. 2A. A person shall not simulate
- 15 intoxication in a public place. A person violating this
- 16 subsection is guilty of a simple misdemeanor.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 This bill relates to simulated public intoxication. The
- 19 bill transfers the criminal offense of simulated public
- 20 intoxication in a public place from Code section 123.46,
- 21 subsection 2, to Code section 123.46, new subsection 2A.
- 22 The bill does not modify the criminal penalty for simulated
- 23 public intoxication. A person who commits simulated public
- 24 intoxication in a public place commits a simple misdemeanor.
- 25 A simple misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no
- 26 more than 30 days or a fine of at least \$65 but not more than
- 27 \$625 or by both.
