## EXPLANATION

8 This bill provides weight limitations for vehicles carrying 9 grain, fertilizer, or agricultural chemicals that currently 10 apply to livestock and construction vehicles. The new weight 11 limitations apply to vehicles with six or seven axles traveling 12 on noninterstate highways.

In addition, current law allows a livestock vehicle with 14 five axles, a minimum distance of 61 feet between the centers 15 of the first and fifth axles, and a minimum distance of eight 16 feet, one inch between the two rear axles to carry a maximum 17 gross weight of 86,000 pounds. The bill extends the weight 18 allowance to similar vehicles carrying grain, fertilizer, or 19 agricultural chemicals.
