Section 1. Section 123.30, subsection 3, paragraph e,
 subparagraph (1), Code Supplement 2009, is amended to read as
 follows:

(1) A class "E" liquor control license may be issued and
shall authorize the holder to purchase alcoholic liquor from
the division only and to sell the alcoholic liquor to patrons
for consumption off the licensed premises and to other liquor
control licensees. A class "E" license shall not be issued to
premises at which gasoline is sold. A holder of a class "E"
liquor control license may hold other retail liquor control
licenses or retail wine or beer permits, but the premises
licensed under a class "E" liquor control license shall be
separate from other licensed premises, though the separate
premises may have a common entrance. However, the holder of
a class "E" liquor control license may also hold a class "B"
wine or class "E" liquor control license.

## EXPLANATION

18

19 This bill allows a class "E" liquor control license to be 20 issued to a premises at which gasoline is sold. Current law 21 does not allow a license to be issued for a location that sells 22 gasoline.
