

**Senate Study Bill 3208 - Introduced**

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act concerning allowable locations for holders of a class  
2 "E" liquor control license.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 123.30, subsection 3, paragraph e,  
2 subparagraph (1), Code Supplement 2009, is amended to read as  
3 follows:

4 (1) A class "E" liquor control license may be issued and  
5 shall authorize the holder to purchase alcoholic liquor from  
6 the division only and to sell the alcoholic liquor to patrons  
7 for consumption off the licensed premises and to other liquor  
8 control licensees. ~~A class "E" license shall not be issued to~~  
9 ~~premises at which gasoline is sold.~~ A holder of a class "E"  
10 liquor control license may hold other retail liquor control  
11 licenses or retail wine or beer permits, but the premises  
12 licensed under a class "E" liquor control license shall be  
13 separate from other licensed premises, though the separate  
14 premises may have a common entrance. However, the holder of  
15 a class "E" liquor control license may also hold a class "B"  
16 wine or class "C" beer permit or both for the premises licensed  
17 under a class "E" liquor control license.

EXPLANATION

19 This bill allows a class "E" liquor control license to be  
20 issued to a premises at which gasoline is sold. Current law  
21 does not allow a license to be issued for a location that sells  
22 gasoline.
