## Senate Study Bill 3232 - Introduced

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## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act providing an Iowa individual income tax checkoff for an
- 2 American red cross natural disaster relief fund for Iowa
- 3 chapters, making an appropriation, providing for the Act's
- 4 implementation, and including effective date and retroactive
- 5 applicability provisions.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **29C.8B American red cross natural** 2 disaster relief fund for Iowa chapters.
- An American red cross natural disaster relief fund for
- 4 Iowa chapters is created in the office of the treasurer under
- 5 the control of the homeland security and emergency management
- 6 division of the department of public defense. The fund is
- 7 composed of moneys appropriated or available to and obtained
- 8 or accepted by the treasurer of the state for deposit in the
- 9 fund. The fund shall include moneys transferred to the fund
- 10 as provided in section 422.12F, and moneys in the form of a
- 11 devise, gift, bequest, donation, or federal or other grant
- 12 intended to be used for the purposes of the fund.
- 2. Notwithstanding section 12C.7, subsection 2, all
- 14 interest or earnings on moneys in the fund shall be credited to
- 15 and remain in the fund. Section 8.33 does not apply to moneys
- 16 in the fund.
- 3. Moneys in the fund that are authorized by the division
- 18 for expenditure are appropriated, and shall be used, for annual
- 19 distributions to Iowa chapters of the American red cross
- 20 solely for the purposes of natural disaster relief within the
- 21 state. Natural disaster relief includes but is not limited to
- 22 emergency food, shelter, and clothing for victims of a natural
- 23 disaster.
- 24 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 422.12F Income tax checkoff for
- 25 American red cross natural disaster relief fund for Iowa
- 26 chapters.
- 27 l. A person who files an individual or a joint income tax
- 28 return with the department of revenue under section 422.13 may
- 29 designate one dollar or more to be paid to the American red
- 30 cross natural disaster relief fund for Iowa chapters as created
- 31 in section 29C.8B. If the refund due on the return or the
- 32 payment remitted with the return is insufficient to pay the
- 33 additional amount designated by the taxpayer to the American
- 34 red cross natural disaster relief fund for Iowa chapters, the
- 35 amount designated shall be reduced to the remaining amount of

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- 1 refund or the remaining amount remitted with the return. The
- 2 designation of a contribution to the American red cross natural
- 3 disaster relief fund for Iowa chapters under this section is
- 4 irrevocable.
- 5 2. The director of revenue shall draft the income tax form
- 6 to allow the designation of contributions to the American red
- 7 cross natural disaster relief fund for Iowa chapters on the
- 8 tax return. The department of revenue, on or before January
- 9 31, shall transfer the total amount designated on the tax
- 10 return forms due in the preceding calendar year to the American
- ll red cross natural disaster relief fund for Iowa chapters.
- 12 However, before a checkoff pursuant to this section shall be
- 13 permitted, all liabilities on the books of the department of
- 14 administrative services and accounts identified as owing under
- 15 section 8A.504 and the political contribution allowed under
- 16 section 68A.601 shall be satisfied.
- 17 3. The homeland security and emergency management division
- 18 may authorize payment of moneys from the American red cross
- 19 natural disaster relief fund for Iowa chapters in accordance
- 20 with section 29C.8B.
- 21 4. The department of revenue shall adopt rules to administer
- 22 this section.
- 23 5. This section is subject to repeal under section 422.12E.
- 24 Sec. 3. IMPLEMENTATION. The income tax checkoff created
- 25 in this Act shall be eligible for placement on the individual
- 26 income tax return form beginning for the tax year commencing
- 27 January 1, 2010, provided the conditions for placement on the
- 28 return form set out in section 422.12E are met.
- 29 Sec. 4. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY. The section of this Act
- 30 enacting section 422.12F applies retroactively to January 1,
- 31 2010, for tax years beginning on or after that date.
- 32 Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
- 33 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 34 EXPLANATION
- 35 This bill provides that taxpayers filing individual or joint

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- 1 income tax returns will be allowed to designate \$1 or more on
- 2 the return form to be paid to the American red cross natural
- 3 disaster relief fund for Iowa chapters. The bill creates the
- 4 fund in the office of the treasurer under the purview of the
- 5 homeland security and emergency management division of the
- 6 department of public defense. The bill requires the department
- 7 of revenue to annually remit moneys collected from the checkoff
- 8 to the fund. Moneys in the fund shall be used solely for the
- 9 purposes of natural disaster relief within the state. Natural
- 10 disaster relief includes but is not limited to emergency food,
- 11 shelter, and clothing for victims of a natural disaster.
- 12 The bill provides that the checkoff is eligible for
- 13 placement on the individual income tax return form for the tax
- 14 year beginning January 1, 2010, and is subject to repeal under
- 15 Code section 422.12E.
- 16 The bill is effective upon enactment. The section of the
- 17 bill enacting the income tax checkoff applies retroactively to
- 18 January 1, 2010, for tax years beginning on or after that date.
