- 6 nonprofit blood bank, as defined in section 141A.1, that is
- 7 licensed by the federal food and drug administration.
- 8 EXPLANATION
- 9 This bill creates a sales tax exemption on the sales price of
- 10 goods sold to or services provided to a nonprofit blood bank
- 11 that is licensed by the federal food and drug administration.
