## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act providing a sales tax exemption for textbooks used in
- 2 attending a postsecondary educational institution.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 14

- 1 Section 1. Section 423.3, Code 2011, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 96. a. The sales price of new and
- 4 used textbooks if the textbooks are for use in attending a
- 5 postsecondary educational institution.
- 6 b. For purposes of this subsection:
- 7 (1) "Textbooks" means books and other instructional
- 8 materials and equipment used in attending a postsecondary
- 9 educational institution in this state, including books and
- 10 materials for extracurricular activities, which include
- 11 sporting events, musical or dramatic events, speech activities,
- 12 or programs of a similar nature. "Textbooks" does not include
- 13 instructional books and materials used in the teaching of
- 14 religious tenets, doctrines, or worship, the purpose of which
- 15 is to inculcate those tenets, doctrines, or worship.
- 16 (2) "Postsecondary educational institution" means an
- 17 accredited higher education institution, as defined in
- 18 section 261.92, an Iowa community college, or a postsecondary
- 19 educational institution under the control of the state board
- 20 of regents.
- 21 c. Postsecondary educational institutions are required to
- 22 provide a list of required and suggested textbooks for all
- 23 courses and the corresponding international standard book
- 24 numbers for such textbooks at least fourteen days, or as soon
- 25 as practicable, before the start of each semester or term, at
- 26 the locations where textbooks are sold on campus and on the
- 27 internet site for the respective postsecondary educational
- 28 institution.
- 29 d. In order to receive the sales tax exemption, a person
- 30 is required to show a current official identification card
- 31 from a postsecondary educational institution and show that the
- 32 textbooks intended to be purchased are on the list of textbooks
- 33 provided by the postsecondary educational institution under
- 34 paragraph "c".
- 35 EXPLANATION

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- 1 This bill provides a sales tax exemption for textbooks used
- 2 in attending a public or private Iowa postsecondary educational
- 3 institution. "Textbooks" are defined as books and other
- 4 instructional materials and equipment, including books and
- 5 materials for extracurricular activities, but does not include
- 6 instructional books and materials used for teaching religious
- 7 tenets, doctrines, or worship if the purpose is to inculcate
- 8 those tenets, doctrines, or worship.
- 9 Postsecondary educational institutions are required
- 10 to provide a list of textbooks for all courses and the
- ll corresponding international standard book numbers for the
- 12 textbooks at least 14 days, or as soon as practicable, before
- 13 the start of each semester or term, where textbooks are sold on
- 14 campus and on the institution's internet site.
- 15 In order to receive the sales tax exemption, a person
- 16 must show a current official identification card from a
- 17 postsecondary educational institution and show that the
- 18 textbooks intended to be purchased are on the institution's
- 19 textbooks list.
- 20 By operation of Code section 423.6, an item exempt from the
- 21 imposition of the sales tax is also exempt from the use tax
- 22 imposed in Code section 423.5.
