A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing a standing appropriation of the fees
2 assessed for radon testing and abatement certification and
3 credentialing for the purpose of the administration of
4 radon-related programs.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 136B.4, Code 2011, is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 **136B.4 Fees — standing appropriation — rules.**

4 1. The department shall establish a fee schedule to defray
5 the costs of the certification and credentialing programs
6 established pursuant to section 136B.1 and the testing
7 conducted and the written reports provided pursuant to section
8 136B.3.

9 2. The proceeds derived from the fees collected under
10 subsection 1 shall be credited to the general fund of the
11 state. The proceeds credited to the general fund of the state
12 under this subsection are appropriated, annually, to the
13 department for administration of the programs established under
14 this chapter.

15 3. The department shall adopt rules, pursuant to chapter
16 17A, to implement this chapter.

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill provides that the proceeds derived from fees
19 collected to defray the costs of radon-related programs under
20 Code chapter 136B are to be credited to the general fund of the
21 state and are appropriated annually to the department of public
22 health for administration of these programs.
