- 1 Section 1. Section 136B.4, Code 2011, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 136B.4 Fees standing appropriation rules.
- 4 l. The department shall establish a fee schedule to defray
- 5 the costs of the certification and credentialing programs
- 6 established pursuant to section 136B.1 and the testing
- 7 conducted and the written reports provided pursuant to section
- 8 136B.3.
- 9 2. The proceeds derived from the fees collected under
- 10 subsection 1 shall be credited to the general fund of the
- 11 state. The proceeds credited to the general fund of the state
- 12 under this subsection are appropriated, annually, to the
- 13 department for administration of the programs established under
- 14 this chapter.
- 15 3. The department shall adopt rules, pursuant to chapter
- 16 17A, to implement this chapter.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 This bill provides that the proceeds derived from fees
- 19 collected to defray the costs of radon-related programs under
- 20 Code chapter 136B are to be credited to the general fund of the
- 21 state and are appropriated annually to the department of public
- 22 health for administration of these programs.
