## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act concerning a policy for the vending of publications at
- 2 rest areas and establishing a fee.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 154

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 314.30 Publication vending at rest 2 areas.
- 3 1. The department shall establish and implement a policy for
- 4 the placement of publication vending equipment at a rest area,
- 5 as defined in section 306C.10, that may include reasonable
- 6 requirements regarding the following:
- 7 a. The size, shape, and appearance of publication racks
- 8 supplied by a vendor.
- 9 b. Standards for regular maintenance of publication racks
- 10 supplied by a vendor.
- 11 c. Requirements for installation of publication racks,
- 12 including acceptable methods for anchoring of equipment.
- 13 d. Location of publication racks within a rest area. In
- 14 allotting an area for the location of publication racks, the
- 15 department shall give primary consideration to the safety of
- 16 pedestrians and vehicles; the unobstructed flow of pedestrian
- 17 traffic; the aesthetic qualities inherent in the design of
- 18 the rest area; and the public's access to and enjoyment of
- 19 amenities within the rest area including but not limited to
- 20 restroom facilities, drinking fountains, food and beverage
- 21 vending machines, information centers as defined in section
- 22 306C.10, and picnic and recreation facilities.
- 23 2. The department shall establish an annual fee for the
- 24 placement of a publication rack at a rest area. The fee shall
- 25 be designed to cover the cost of administering this section,
- 26 not to exceed five hundred dollars per publication rack at a
- 27 single rest area.
- 28 3. A person desiring to place a publication rack at a rest
- 29 area shall make application to the department in a manner
- 30 approved by the department. Upon approval of the application
- 31 and payment of the proper fee, the department shall issue a
- 32 permit valid for one year.
- 33 4. In lieu of or in addition to prescribing requirements for
- 34 the installation of multiple publication racks within a rest
- 35 area, the department may require publications to be sold or

- 1 distributed from a combination rack or modular unit provided by
- 2 the department for the vending of multiple publications. The
- 3 vending of publications under this subsection shall be subject
- 4 to the fee and permit requirements under subsections 2 and 3.
- 5 5. The department may adopt rules as necessary to administer
- 6 this section. The rules may include but shall not be limited
- 7 to procedures for the issuance of multiple permits to a vendor
- 8 or for a single permit covering multiple locations, procedures
- 9 for permit renewals, and remedies for addressing violations of
- 10 the conditions of a permit.
- 11 6. For purposes of this section, "vending" includes both
- 12 sales and free distribution.
- 13 EXPLANATION
- 14 This bill establishes a uniform process for the sale or free
- 15 distribution of newspapers and other publications at rest areas
- 16 on interstates and primary highways by requiring publication
- 17 vendors to acquire a state permit and pay an annual fee.
- 18 The bill requires the department of transportation
- 19 to establish and implement a policy for the placement of
- 20 publication vending equipment at rest areas. The policy is
- 21 to include reasonable requirements for the size, shape, and
- 22 appearance of publication racks; standards for maintenance and
- 23 upkeep; installation and anchoring requirements; and location
- 24 requirements. A person who desires to place a publication rack
- 25 in a rest area must first apply to the department for an annual
- 26 permit and pay a fee established by the department to cover its
- 27 administrative costs, not to exceed \$500 per rack at a rest
- 28 area.
- 29 The bill provides an option for the department to install
- 30 combination racks or modular units for the vending of multiple
- 31 publications and require their use in place of individual
- 32 publication racks, subject to the same permit and fee
- 33 requirements applicable to individual rack placement.
- 34 The bill authorizes the department to adopt rules to
- 35 administer the provisions of the bill.
