## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act establishing a one-week waiting period prior to the
- 2 receipt of unemployment compensation benefits and including
- 3 effective date and applicability provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 96.4, Code 2011, is amended by adding the 2 following new subsection:

3 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 8. *a.* The individual has satisfied a 4 one-week waiting period during the individual's benefit year. 5 To satisfy the waiting period, the individual, with respect to 6 the week in question:

7 (1) Must be unemployed.

8 (2) Must have filed a claim for benefits in accordance with 9 the provisions of section 96.6, subsection 1.

10 (3) Must be eligible for benefits from this state. However, 11 during the one-week waiting period, the individual must not 12 have received benefits from this state or any other state, and 13 must not be eligible for benefits from any other state. 14 b. If the individual has satisfied the one-week waiting 15 period and the department finds the individual is eligible 16 for benefits for the week subsequent to the one-week waiting

17 period, the individual shall then be paid benefits for the 18 one-week waiting period provided the individual meets all other 19 eligibility requirements of this section.

20 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect July 3, 2011. 21 Sec. 3. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to unemployment 22 compensation benefit claims with an effective date on or after 23 July 3, 2011.

## EXPLANATION

This bill requires an individual to satisfy a one-week waiting period during the individual's benefit year in order to receive unemployment compensation benefits. The bill requires that, regarding the week in question, the individual y must be unemployed, must have filed a claim for benefits in accordance with Code section 96.6(1), and must be eligible for benefits in the state of Iowa. The bill requires that the individual, regarding the week in question, must not have received unemployment compensation benefits from the state of Iowa or any other state, and must not have been eligible to receive benefits from any other state. The bill also provides

1 that the individual will be eligible to receive benefits for 2 the one-week waiting period, provided that the department of 3 workforce development finds, for the week immediately following 4 the one-week waiting period, that the individual satisfied all 5 other requirements of Code section 96.4.

6 The bill is effective July 3, 2011, and applies to 7 unemployment compensation benefit claims effective on or after 8 July 3, 2011.
