- 1 Section 1. Section 234.46, subsection 1, paragraph c, Code
- 2 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 c. At the time the person became age eighteen, the either of 4 the following circumstances applied:
- 5 (1) The person received foster care services that were
- 6 paid for by the state under section 234.35 and the person is no
- 7 longer receiving such services.
- 8 (2) The person received foster care services that were paid
- 9 for by the state under section 234.35 during all or a portion
- 10 of the forty-eight-month period prior to the person becoming
- 11 age eighteen, the person was adopted prior to becoming age
- 12 eighteen, and adoption subsidy payments are no longer being
- 13 made under section 600.17 on behalf of the person.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- 15 This bill relates to eligibility for the preparation for
- 16 adult living program administered by the department of human
- 17 services. The program provides support to young adults, age
- 18 18, 19, or 20, who were in foster care upon becoming age
- 19 18. The support is limited to young adults who are attending
- 20 school or instructional programs, or postsecondary training or
- 21 education, or are engaged in employment or seeking employment.
- The bill expands program eligibility to include persons who
- 23 received foster care paid for by the state at some point during
- 24 the 48-month period before becoming age 18 but were adopted.
- 25 The person is not eligible for the program if adoption subsidy
- 26 payments are still being made on behalf of the person.
