## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the education requirements for licensed
- 2 massage therapists.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 2126

- 1 Section 1. Section 152C.3, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code 2 Supplement 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 a. Completion of a curriculum of massage education at a
- 4 school approved by the board which requires for admission a
- 5 diploma from an accredited high school or the equivalent and
- 6 requires completion of at least six hundred hours of supervised
- 7 academic instruction. However, educational requirements under
- 8 this paragraph are subject to reduction by the board if, after
- 9 public notice and hearing, the board determines that the
- 10 welfare of the public may be adequately protected with fewer
- 11 hours of education.
- 12 EXPLANATION
- 13 In order to be licensed under current law, a massage
- 14 therapist must complete a massage education curriculum at a
- 15 school approved by the board of massage therapy requiring at
- 16 least 600 hours of supervised academic instruction. This bill
- 17 eliminates the 600-hour requirement.
