A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to salary increases for the presidents of the
- 2 institutions of higher learning governed by the state board
- 3 of regents and including effective date provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 262.9, subsection 2, Code Supplement
- 2 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- Elect a president of each of the institutions of higher
- 4 learning; a superintendent of each of the other institutions;
- 5 a treasurer and a secretarial officer for each institution
- 6 annually; professors, instructors, officers, and employees; and
- 7 fix their compensation.
- 8 a. The board shall not increase the compensation or benefits
- 9 paid or provided to any president of an institution of higher
- 10 learning for the fiscal year following a fiscal year during
- 11 which the board approved a tuition increase for any of the
- 12 institutions of higher learning.
- 13 b. Sections 279.12 through 279.19 and section 279.27 apply
- 14 to employees of the Iowa braille and sight saving school and
- 15 the state school for the deaf, who are licensed pursuant to
- 16 chapter 272. In following those sections in chapter 279, the
- 17 references to boards of directors of school districts shall be
- 18 interpreted to apply to the board of regents.
- 19 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. This Act, being deemed of
- 20 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 21 EXPLANATION
- 22 This bill prohibits the state board of regents from
- 23 increasing the compensation or benefits paid or provided to any
- 24 president of a regents university in the fiscal year following
- 25 a fiscal year during which the board increased the tuition at
- 26 any regents university.
- 27 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
