A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to bag limits during regular gun and late
- 2 muzzleloader deer hunting seasons.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 483A.8, subsection 2, Code Supplement 2 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 2. a. The A deer hunting license shall be accompanied by
- 4 a tag designed to be used only once. When a deer is taken,
- 5 the deer shall be tagged and the tag shall be dated. The tag
- 6 shall be attached to the carcass of a deer taken within fifteen
- 7 minutes of the time the deer carcass is located after being
- 8 taken, or before the carcass is moved to be transported by any
- 9 means from the place where the deer was taken, whichever occurs
- 10 first. For each antlered deer taken, the tag shall be affixed
- 11 to the deer's antlers.
- 12 b. During regular gun seasons and the late muzzleloader
- 13 season, the bag limit for a hunting party is one deer for each
- 14 hunter in the party who has a valid transportation tag. The
- 15 possession limit is one deer per license. For purposes of
- 16 this paragraph, "hunting party" means two or more persons who
- 17 each have a deer hunting license and tag, and who are hunting
- 18 together. For purposes of this paragraph, "possession" means
- 19 that the deer is in the possession of the person whose license
- 20 number matches the number of the transportation tag on the
- 21 carcass of the deer.
- 22 EXPLANATION
- 23 This bill provides that during regular gun and the late
- 24 muzzleloader deer hunting seasons, the daily bag limit for a
- 25 hunting party is one deer for each hunter in the party who has
- 26 a valid transportation tag. The possession limit is one deer
- 27 per deer hunting license and the deer must be in the possession
- 28 of the person whose license number matches the number of the
- 29 transportation tag on the carcass of the deer.
- 30 Currently, the natural resource commission's administrative
- 31 rules only allow such bag limits for hunting parties during
- 32 regular gun deer hunting seasons. During all other seasons,
- 33 the deer must be shot and tagged only by the person in whose
- 34 name the license and tag was issued. For purposes of the bill,
- 35 a "hunting party" is two or more persons who each have a deer
