A BILL FOR

An Act authorizing certain students to enroll in a career and
technical course offered through a district-to-community
college sharing program for high school credit only,
exempting such students from proficiency requirements, and
prohibiting school districts from receiving supplementary
weighting for such students.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 257.11, subsection 3, paragraph b, 2 unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2011, is amended to read as 3 follows:

4 If the school budget review committee certifies to the 5 department of management that the class would not otherwise be 6 implemented without the assignment of additional weighting, 7 pupils who meet the senior year plus program student 8 eligibility criteria pursuant to section 261E.3, subsection 9 1, attending a community college-offered class or attending 10 a class taught by a community college-employed instructor 11 are assigned a weighting of the percentage of the pupil's 12 school day during which the pupil attends class in the 13 community college or attends a class taught by a community 14 college-employed instructor times seventy hundredths for career 15 and technical courses or forty-six hundredths for liberal arts 16 and sciences courses. The following requirements shall be 17 met for the purposes of assigning an additional weighting for 18 classes offered through a sharing agreement between a school 19 district and community college. The class must be: 20 Sec. 2. Section 260C.14, subsection 21, paragraph a, Code 21 2011, is amended by adding the following new subparagraph: 22 NEW SUBPARAGRAPH. (05) Unduplicated headcount of pupils 23 who are enrolled in a district-to-community college sharing 24 program for high school credit only in accordance with section 25 261E.8, subsection 6A.

26 Sec. 3. Section 261E.8, Code Supplement 2011, is amended by 27 adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 6A. Notwithstanding section 261E.3, subsection 1, if a school district's student registration handbook includes notice of the availability of a career and technical course pursuant to subsection 1, a student enrolled in the school district may make application to a community college and the school district to allow the student to enroll in the career and technical course offered by the community college for high school credit only. If the student applies

1 only for high school credit, the student is exempt from the 2 proficiency requirements of section 261E.3, subsection 1, 3 paragraph "e'', and the school district shall not receive 4 additional weighting for the student's enrollment in the course 5 under section 257.11, subsection 3. Sec. 4. Section 261E.8, subsection 7, paragraph b, Code 6 7 Supplement 2011, is amended to read as follows: 8 *b*. An unduplicated enrollment count of eligible 9 students participating in the program, and a separate 10 unduplicated enrollment count of students participating in 11 district-to-community college programs for high school credit 12 only in accordance with subsection 6A. 13 EXPLANATION 14 This bill provides that if a school district's 15 student registration handbook includes notice of the 16 availability of a career and technical course offered under 17 a district-to-community college sharing program, a student 18 enrolled in the school district may make application to a 19 community college and the school district to allow the student 20 to enroll in the career and technical course to receive high 21 school credit only. If the student applies only for high 22 school credit, the student is exempt from the proficiency 23 requirements of Code section 261E.3, subsection 1, paragraph 24 "e", and the school district shall not receive additional 25 supplementary weighting for the student's enrollment in the 26 course. 27 The bill requires community colleges and the state board of 28 education to include a count of these students in the reports 29 and data collection elements currently required through the 30 department of education's management information system and the 31 district-to-community college and concurrent enrollment program 32 requirements.
