A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act requiring the state board of regents to provide for a
- 2 reduction in undergraduate resident tuition for residents
- 3 who earn an associate degree at an Iowa community college
- 4 and who transfer to an institution of higher education
- 5 governed by the board.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 262.9, subsection 17, Code Supplement
- 2 2011, is amended by adding the following new paragraph:
- 3 NEW PARAGRAPH. c. Adopt rules to require the institutions
- 4 of higher education under the board to reduce the resident
- 5 undergraduate tuition rate by not less than ten percent
- 6 for a person who is a resident and who transfers to such an
- 7 institution after obtaining an associate degree from an Iowa
- 8 community college. The reduction shall be applied to the
- 9 tuition charged a student prior to the disbursement of any
- 10 financial aid for which the student is eligible.
- 11 EXPLANATION
- 12 This bill directs the state board of regents to require its
- 13 universities to reduce the resident undergraduate tuition rate
- 14 by not less than 10 percent for a person who is a resident and
- 15 who obtains from an Iowa community college an associate degree
- 16 and transfers to a regents university. The reduction shall
- 17 be applied to the tuition charged before any financial aid is
- 18 disbursed for the student.
