2 amended to read as follows:

1. A petition for incorporation, discontinuance, or 3 4 boundary adjustment may be filed with the board by a city 5 council, a county board of supervisors, a regional planning 6 authority, or five percent of the registered voters of a 7 city or territory involved in the proposal. A petition for 8 discontinuance or boundary adjustment may be filed with the 9 board by a city council, a county board of supervisors, a 10 regional planning authority, or five percent of the registered 11 voters of the city involved in the proposal. Notice of the 12 filing, including a copy of the petition, must be served upon 13 the council of each city for which a discontinuance or boundary 14 adjustment is proposed, the board of supervisors for each 15 county which contains a portion of a city to be discontinued or 16 territory to be incorporated, annexed or severed, the council 17 of a city if an incorporation includes territory within the 18 city's urbanized area, and any regional planning authority for 19 the area involved.

EXPLANATION

This bill modifies the filing requirements for petitions to the city development board involving involuntary city adevelopment action by specifying that a petition for incorporation must be filed with the city development board by 5 percent of registered voters of a territory involved in the proposal, and a petition for discontinuance or boundary adjustment must be filed with the city development board by percent of registered voters of the city involved in the proposal.
