A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to rules for compensation under the medical
- 2 assistance program of individuals holding certain positions
- 3 in nursing facilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. RULES RELATING TO COMPENSATION OF NURSING
- 2 FACILITY EMPLOYEES. The department of human services shall
- 3 amend administrative rules adopted pursuant to chapter 249A
- 4 relating to limitations of expenses relating to a reasonable
- 5 allowance of compensation for services of owners of nursing
- 6 facilities or their immediate relatives under the medical
- 7 assistance program as specified in 441 IAC 81.6(11)(h) to
- 8 provide all of the following:
- 9 1. With regard to what constitutes compensation, the rules
- 10 shall provide that the costs of benefits, excluding employment
- 11 taxes but including group health insurance, retirement plans,
- 12 and education or other benefits, shall not be included in the
- 13 computation of the base maximum allowed compensation amount.
- 14 However, the costs attributable to such benefits shall not
- 15 exceed twenty percent of the amount that constitutes such base
- 16 maximum allowed compensation amount. A nursing facility shall
- 17 provide documentation of the costs of any benefits excluded
- 18 from the compensation for any related party.
- 19 2. In determining reasonableness of compensation, the facts
- 20 and circumstances of the case shall include whether the nursing
- 21 facility is located in a rural or urban area.
- 3. Beginning July 1, 2012, in determining the base maximum
- 23 allowed compensation for an administrator on a biannual
- 24 basis, the maximum allowed compensation amounts for such
- 25 administrators shall be calculated based upon the previous
- 26 year's averages of all nonrelated party administrators and
- 27 shall be increased or decreased by the inflation factor
- 28 specified in 441 IAC 81.6(18).
- 4. Beginning July 1, 2012, the maximum allowed compensation
- 30 for any other employee of a facility who has a five percent
- 31 or greater interest in ownership of the facility shall not
- 32 exceed seventy-five percent of the amount allowed for the
- 33 administrator of the facility.
- 34 Sec. 2. ADMINISTRATIVE RULES. The department of human
- 35 services may adopt emergency rules under section 17A.4,

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- 1 subsection 3, and section 17A.5, subsection 2, paragraph "b", 2 to implement the provisions of this Act, and the rules shall 3 be effective immediately upon filing unless a later date is
- 4 specified in the rules. Any rules adopted in accordance with
- 5 this section shall also be published as a notice of intended
- 6 action as provided in section 17A.4.
- 7 EXPLANATION
- 8 This bill directs the department of human services to amend
- 9 administrative rules relating to what constitutes compensation
- 10 for services of owners of nursing facilities or their immediate 11 relatives under the medical assistance program. Benefits such
- 12 as group health insurance, retirement plans, and education or
- 13 other benefits are not to be included in the computation of the
- 14 base maximum allowed compensation amount, but are limited to 20
- 15 percent of such base maximum allowed compensation amount. The
- 16 determination of reasonableness of compensation is to include
- 17 whether the facility is located in a rural or urban area; the
- 18 determination of the base maximum allowed compensation for
- 19 an administrator is to include a comparison with all other
- 20 administrators plus an inflation amount; and the determination
- 21 of compensation for other employees who have at least a 5
- 22 percent ownership interest in the facility is not to exceed
- 23 75 percent of the amount allowed for the administrator of the
- 24 facility. The bill provides for adoption of emergency rules.
