2 amended to read as follows:

7. The costs of special education instructional programs
<u>when contracted with a private agency</u> include <u>the costs of</u>
<u>general administration, health service, attendance officers,</u>
<u>plant operation, and plant maintenance, instructional costs,</u>
<u>and the costs of purchase of equipment, transportation</u>
<u>equipment, and insurance</u> to meet the special needs of children
<u>requiring special education with the approval of the director</u>
of the department of education. The state board of education
shall adopt rules under chapter 17A for the purchase of
<u>transportation equipment pursuant to administer this section.</u>
<u>EXPLANATION</u>

14 This bill adds the costs of general administration, health 15 service, attendance officers, plant operation, and plant 16 maintenance, instructional costs, and the costs of purchase 17 of equipment, transportation, and insurance to the included 18 costs that are covered by funds for school districts for excess 19 costs of instruction of children requiring special education 20 when contracted with a private agency. Covered costs currently 21 include the cost of purchase of transportation equipment when 22 contracted with an area education agency, another school 23 district, or a private agency. The bill directs the state 24 board of education to adopt rules to administer the bill.
