A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the transfer tax imposed on insurers
- 2 organized in other states who elect to become domestic
- 3 insurers in Iowa.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Section 508.12, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2 2011, is amended to read as follows: An insurer which is organized under the laws of any state, 4 and is admitted to do business in this state for the purpose 5 of writing insurance authorized by this chapter may become a 6 domestic insurer by complying with section 490.902 or 491.33 7 and with all of the requirements of law relative to the 8 organization and licensing of a domestic insurer of the same 9 type and by designating its principal place of business in this 10 state, and, upon payment to the commissioner of insurance of 11 a transfer tax in a sum equal to twenty-five percent of the 12 premium tax paid pursuant to the provisions of chapter 432 13 for the last calendar year immediately preceding its becoming 14 a domestic corporation or the sum of ten thousand dollars, 15 whichever is the lesser but not less than one thousand dollars, 16 may become a domestic corporation and be entitled to like 17 certificates of its corporate existence and license to transact 18 business in this state, and be subject in all respects to the 19 authority and jurisdiction thereof. 20 Sec. 2. Section 515.78, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2011, 21 is amended to read as follows: An insurer which is organized under the laws of any state, 22 23 and is admitted to do business in this state for the purpose 24 of writing insurance authorized by this chapter may become a 25 domestic insurer by complying with section 490.902 or 491.33 26 and with all of the requirements of law relative to the 27 organization and licensing of a domestic insurer of the same 28 type and by designating its principal place of business in this 29 state, and, upon payment to the commissioner of insurance of 30 a transfer tax in a sum equal to twenty-five percent of the 31 premium tax paid pursuant to the provisions of chapter 432 32 for the last calendar year immediately preceding its becoming 33 a domestic corporation or the sum of ten thousand dollars, 34 whichever is the lesser but not less than one thousand dollars, 35 may become a domestic corporation and be entitled to like
