- 1 An Act granting home rule power and authority, subject to
- 2 certain limitations, to school districts.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 274.3 Exercise of powers.
- School districts are granted home rule power and
- 3 authority, not inconsistent with the laws of the general
- 4 assembly, to determine their local affairs and government,
- 5 except that they shall not have power to levy any tax unless
- 6 expressly authorized by the general assembly.
- 7 2. If the power or authority of a school district conflicts
- 8 with the power and authority of a municipal corporation,
- 9 county, or joint county-municipal corporation, the power and
- 10 authority exercised by a municipal corporation, county, or
- 11 joint county-municipal corporation shall prevail within its
- 12 jurisdiction.
- 3. The rule or proposition of law that a school district
- 14 possesses and can exercise only those powers granted in express
- 15 words is not a part of the law of this state.
- 16 EXPLANATION
- 17 This bill relates to the power and authority of school
- 18 districts by amending Code chapter 274 to grant school
- 19 districts home rule power and authority, not inconsistent with
- 20 the laws of the general assembly, to determine their local
- 21 affairs and government. Such power and authority, however,
- 22 does not include the power to levy any tax unless expressly
- 23 authorized by the general assembly. If the school district's
- 24 power or authority conflicts with that of a municipal
- 25 corporation, county, or joint county-municipal corporation, the
- 26 power or authority of the municipal corporation, county, or
- 27 joint county-municipal corporation shall prevail.
- 28 The bill provides that the rule or proposition of law that a
- 29 school district possesses and can exercise only those powers
- 30 granted in express words is not part of the law of Iowa.
