A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act requiring health insurance coverage of certain services
- 2 provided by licensed marital and family therapists and
- 3 mental health counselors and including applicability
- 4 provisions.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **514C.29 Coverage of services**2 provided by marital and family therapists and mental health
 3 counselors.
- 4 l. Notwithstanding the uniformity of treatment requirements
- 5 of section 514C.6, a policy or contract, or plan established
- 6 pursuant to chapter 509A, providing for third-party payment
- 7 or prepayment of health or medical expenses that provides
- 8 reimbursement for any mental or behavioral health service
- 9 which is in the lawful scope of practice of a marital and
- 10 family therapist or mental health counselor who is licensed
- 11 pursuant to chapter 154D, shall provide reimbursement on an
- 12 equitable basis to the marital and family therapist or mental
- 13 health counselor for the provision of that service at a rate
- 14 commensurate with the requirements of licensure of that person.
- 15 2. This section shall not apply to accident-only,
- 16 specified disease, short-term hospital or medical, hospital
- 17 confinement indemnity, credit, dental, vision, Medicare
- 18 supplement, long-term care, basic hospital and medical-surgical
- 19 expense coverage as defined by the commissioner, disability
- 20 income insurance coverage, coverage issued as a supplement
- 21 to liability insurance, workers' compensation or similar
- 22 insurance, or automobile medical payment insurance.
- 23 Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to a third-party
- 24 payment provider policy or contract, or plan established
- 25 pursuant to chapter 509A, that is delivered, issued for
- 26 delivery, continued, or renewed in this state on or after
- 27 January 1, 2012.
- 28 EXPLANATION
- 29 This bill creates new Code section 514C.29 which requires
- 30 any policies, contracts, or plans established pursuant to Code
- 31 chapter 509A, providing for third-party payment or prepayment
- 32 of health or medical care expenses, that provide reimbursement
- 33 for any mental or behavioral health service which is in the
- 34 lawful scope of practice of a marital and family therapist or
- 35 mental health counselor licensed pursuant to Code chapter 154D,

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- 1 to reimburse such a therapist or counselor for the provision
- 2 of that service at a rate commensurate with that person's
- 3 requirements of licensure.
- 4 The bill is applicable to policies, contracts, or plans
- 5 delivered, issued for delivery, continued, or renewed in this
- 6 state on or after January 1, 2012.
- 7 The bill is not applicable to certain specified types of
- 8 insurance coverage.
