- 1 Section 1. Section 422.12, subsection 2, Code 2011, is
- 2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:
- 3 NEW PARAGRAPH. c. (1) A home school credit equal to
- 4 twenty-five percent of the amount expended for the purchase
- 5 of textbooks for each dependent receiving competent private
- 6 instruction as defined in section 299A.1.
- 7 (2) The department, when conducting an audit of a taxpayer's
- 8 return, shall also audit the home school tax credit portion of
- 9 the tax return.
- 10 Sec. 2. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY. This Act applies
- 11 retroactively to January 1, 2011, for tax years beginning on
- 12 or after that date.
- 13 EXPLANATION
- 14 This bill provides a tax credit equal to 25 percent of
- 15 the amount expended for the purchase of textbooks for each
- 16 dependent attending home schooling.
- 17 The bill applies retroactively to January 1, 2011, for tax
- 18 years beginning on or after that date.
