- 1 An Act relating to administrators of school districts and area
- 2 education agencies and providing a penalty.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

H.F. 325

- 1 Section 1. Section 256.9, subsection 51, Code 2011, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 51. a. Develop Iowa standards for school district and
- 4 area education agency administrators, including knowledge and
- 5 skill criteria, and develop, based on the Iowa standards for
- 6 administrators, mentoring and induction, evaluation processes,
- 7 and professional development plans pursuant to chapter 284A.
- 8 The criteria shall further define the characteristics of
- 9 quality administrators as established by the Iowa standards for
- 10 school administrators.
- ll b. Define the qualifications, duties, and responsibilities
- 12 of school district and area education agency administrators,
- 13 other than superintendents and chief administrators, which
- 14 a school district or area education agency shall use in
- 15 determining administrator salaries in accordance with section
- 16 273.3A, subsection 2, or section 279.25A, subsection 2, as
- 17 appropriate.
- 18 Sec. 2. Section 273.3, subsection 11, Code 2011, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- 20 ll. Employ personnel to carry out the functions of the
- 21 area education agency which shall include the employment of an
- 22 administrator who shall possess a license issued under chapter
- 23 272. The administrator shall be employed pursuant to section
- 24 279.20 and sections 279.23, 279.24, and 279.25. The salary for
- 25 an area education agency administrator shall be established by
- 26 the board based upon the previous experience and education of
- 27 the administrator. However, the salary limitations and the
- 28 penalty established pursuant to section 273.3A shall apply.
- 29 Section 279.13 applies to the area education agency board
- 30 and to all teachers employed by the area education agency.
- 31 Sections 279.23, 279.24, and 279.25 apply to the area education
- 32 board and to all administrators employed by the area education
- 33 agency.
- 34 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 273.3A Administrative salary limits —
- 35 state aid penalty.

- 1 l. If a chief administrator is employed by an area education
- 2 agency pursuant to section 273.3, the maximum annual base
- 3 salary paid by the board of directors of the area education
- 4 agency to the chief administrator, if the chief administrator
- 5 is not employed jointly with another area education agency,
- 6 shall not exceed an amount equivalent to two and one-half times
- 7 the highest maximum annual base teacher salary paid by a school
- 8 district located within the boundaries of the area education
- 9 agency, exclusive of extra duty pay.
- 10 2. If an administrator as defined pursuant to section
- 11 256.9, subsection 51, paragraph "b", is employed by an area
- 12 education agency pursuant to section 273.3, the maximum
- 13 annual base salary paid by the board of directors of the area
- 14 education agency to a principal or assistant administrator, if
- 15 the administrator is not employed jointly with another area
- 16 education agency, shall not exceed an amount equivalent to one
- 17 and three-fourths times the highest maximum annual base teacher
- 18 salary paid by a school district located within the boundaries
- 19 of the area education agency, exclusive of extra duty pay.
- 20 3. An administrator who meets the requirements of
- 21 subsection 1 or 2 is ineligible for extra duty pay from an area
- 22 education agency.
- 23 4. If the department of education determines that an area
- 24 education agency is not in compliance with this section, the
- 25 department shall instruct the director of the department
- 26 of management to withhold state aid to the area education
- 27 agency in an amount equivalent to the amount by which the area
- 28 education agency exceeded the limits established pursuant to
- 29 this section.
- 30 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. 279.25A Administrator salary limits —
- 31 state aid penalty.
- 32 1. The maximum annual base salary paid by the board of
- 33 directors of a school district to the superintendent of the
- 34 school district, if the superintendent is not employed jointly
- 35 with another school district under section 280.15, shall not

- 1 exceed an amount equivalent to two and one-half times the
- 2 highest maximum annual base teacher salary, exclusive of extra
- 3 duty pay, paid by the school district.
- 4 2. The maximum annual base salary paid by the board of
- 5 directors of a school district to an administrator as defined
- 6 pursuant to section 256.9, subsection 51, paragraph "b", if
- 7 the administrator is not employed jointly with another school
- 8 district under section 280.15, shall not exceed an amount
- 9 equivalent to one and three-fourths times the highest maximum
- 10 annual base teacher salary, exclusive of extra duty pay, paid
- 11 by the school district.
- 12 3. An administrator who meets the requirements of
- 13 subsection 1 or 2 is ineligible for extra duty pay from a
- 14 school district.
- 15 4. If the department of education determines that a school
- 16 district is not in compliance with this section, the department
- 17 shall instruct the director of the department of management
- 18 to withhold state aid to the school district in an amount
- 19 equivalent to the amount by which the school district exceeded
- 20 the limits established pursuant to this section.
- 21 EXPLANATION
- 22 This bill limits the maximum annual base salary paid by
- 23 the board of directors of school districts and area education
- 24 agencies (AEAs) to administrators, and directs the director
- 25 of the department of education to define the qualifications,
- 26 duties, and responsibilities of school district and AEA
- 27 administrators, which the school districts and AEAs must use in
- 28 determining administrator salaries.
- 29 The bill limits the maximum annual base salary paid to a
- 30 superintendent of the school district or chief administrator
- 31 of an AEA, if the superintendent or chief administrator is
- 32 not employed jointly with another school district or AEA,
- 33 respectively, to not more than an amount equivalent to 2.5
- 34 times the highest maximum annual base teacher salary, exclusive
- 35 of extra duty pay, paid by the school district or, in the case

- 1 of the chief administrator of an AEA, paid by a school district
- 2 within the boundaries of the AEA.
- 3 For administrators as defined by the director, the amount
- 4 is limited to an amount equivalent to 1.75 times the highest
- 5 maximum annual base teacher salary, exclusive of extra duty 6 pay.
- 7 The bill provides that administrators under these salary
- 8 restrictions are ineligible for extra duty pay.
- 9 If the department of education determines that a school
- 10 district or AEA is noncompliant, the department shall instruct
- 11 the director of the department of management to withhold state
- 12 aid to the school district or AEA in an amount equivalent to
- 13 the amount by which the school district or AEA exceeded the
- 14 compensation limits.
