A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act prohibiting the state board of education from adopting
- 2 certain federal standards and regulations without specific
- 3 statutory authorization.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 256.7, subsection 26, Code 2011, is
- 2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:
- 3 NEW PARAGRAPH. d. The state board shall not adopt federal
- 4 standards or regulations relating to the core curriculum
- 5 established pursuant to this subsection or to the core content
- 6 standards adopted pursuant to subsection 28 unless specifically
- 7 authorized by statute to adopt such federal standards and
- 8 regulations.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 256.7, subsection 28, Code 2011, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 28. Adopt a set of core content standards applicable to
- 12 all students in kindergarten through grade twelve in every
- 13 school district and accredited nonpublic school. For purposes
- 14 of this subsection, "core content standards" includes reading,
- 15 mathematics, and science. The core content standards shall
- 16 be identical to the core content standards included in Iowa's
- 17 approved 2006 standards and assessment system under Tit. I
- 18 of the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act of
- 19 1965, 20 U.S.C. § 6301 et seq., as amended by the federal No
- 20 Child Left Behind Act of 2001, Pub. L. No. 107-110. School
- 21 districts and accredited nonpublic schools shall include, at a
- 22 minimum, the core content standards adopted pursuant to this
- 23 subsection in any set of locally developed content standards.
- 24 School districts and accredited nonpublic schools are strongly
- 25 encouraged to set higher expectations in local standards. As
- 26 changes in federal law or regulation occur, the state board is
- 27 authorized to shall not amend the core content standards as
- 28 appropriate unless specifically authorized by statute.
- 29 EXPLANATION
- 30 This bill prohibits the state board of education from
- 31 adopting federal standards or regulations relating to the
- 32 core curriculum established by the state board or to the core
- 33 content standards adopted by the state board without specific
- 34 statutory authority to adopt the standards or regulations.
- 35 The bill also prohibits the state board from amending

- 1 the core content standards unless specifically authorized by
- 2 statute.
