A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the duties and rulemaking authority of the
- 2 commission on veterans affairs.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 35A.3, subsection 2, Code 2011, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 2. Review and approve, prior to adoption, all proposed
- 4 rules submitted by the department concerning the management
- 5 and operation of the department and programs administered by
- 6 the department. Unless the commission votes to disapprove a
- 7 proposed rule on a two-thirds vote at the earlier of the next
- 8 regularly scheduled meeting of the commission or a special
- 9 meeting of the commission called by the commission within
- 10 thirty days of the date the proposed rule is submitted, the
- 11 department may proceed to adopt the rule.
- 12 Sec. 2. Section 35A.3, Code 2011, is amended by adding the
- 13 following new subsections:
- 14 NEW SUBSECTION. 6. Provide guidance and make
- 15 recommendations to the department during an annual review of
- 16 the department's proposed budget and provide guidance and make
- 17 recommendations for budget changes that occur during the fiscal
- 18 year.
- 19 NEW SUBSECTION. 7. Consult with the department
- 20 regarding certification training for executive directors
- 21 and administrators of county commissions of veteran affairs
- 22 pursuant to section 35B.6.
- 23 Sec. 3. Section 35A.5, subsection 9, Code 2011, is amended
- 24 to read as follows:
- 9. After consultation with the commission, provide
- 26 certification training to executive directors and
- 27 administrators of county commissions of veteran affairs
- 28 pursuant to section 35B.6. Training provided under this
- 29 subsection shall include accreditation by the national
- 30 association of county veteran service officers. Training
- 31 provided by the department shall be certified by the national
- 32 association of county veteran service officers and, in
- 33 addition, shall ensure that each executive director and
- 34 administrator is proficient in the use of electronic mail,
- 35 general computer use, and use of the internet to access

- 1 information regarding facilities, benefits, and services
- 2 available to veterans and their families. The department
- 3 commission may adopt rules in accordance with chapter 17A
- 4 to provide for training of county veteran affairs executive
- 5 directors and administrators.
- 6 Sec. 4. Section 35A.5, subsection 12, Code 2011, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 12. Adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A and establish policy
- 9 for the management and operation of the department. Prior to
- 10 adopting rules, the department shall submit proposed rules
- 11 to the commission for review and approval pursuant to the
- 12 requirements of section 35A.3.
- 13 Sec. 5. Section 35A.8, subsection 4, paragraph a, Code 2011,
- 14 is amended to read as follows:
- 15 a. The executive director shall provide for the
- 16 administration of the bonus authorized in this subsection. The
- 17 department commission shall adopt rules, pursuant to chapter
- 18 17A, as necessary to administer this subsection including, but
- 19 not limited to, application procedures, investigation, approval
- 20 or disapproval, and payment of claims.
- 21 Sec. 6. Section 35A.8, subsection 5, paragraph a, Code 2011,
- 22 is amended to read as follows:
- 23 a. The executive director shall provide for the
- 24 administration of the bonus authorized in this subsection. The
- 25 department commission shall adopt rules, pursuant to chapter
- 26 17A, as necessary to administer this subsection including but
- 27 not limited to application procedures, investigation, approval
- 28 or disapproval, and payment of claims.
- 29 Sec. 7. Section 35A.8A, subsection 7, Code 2011, is amended
- 30 to read as follows:
- 31 7. The executive director of the department of veterans
- 32 affairs shall provide for the administration of the bonus
- 33 authorized in this section. The department commission
- 34 shall adopt rules, pursuant to chapter 17A, as necessary
- 35 to administer this section including but not limited to

- 1 application procedures, investigation, approval or disapproval,
- 2 and payment of claims. The department commission may expend
- 3 up to one percent of the moneys appropriated for the bonus
- 4 compensation authorized under this section for administrative
- 5 costs associated with the requirements of this section.
- 6 Sec. 8. Section 35A.13, subsection 5, Code 2011, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 5. It is the intent of the general assembly that beginning
- 9 with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008, appropriations
- 10 be made annually to the veterans trust fund. Prior to any
- 11 additional appropriations to this fund, the department
- 12 commission shall provide the general assembly with information
- 13 identifying immediate and long-term veteran services throughout
- 14 the state and a plan for delivering those services.
- 15 Sec. 9. Section 35A.13, subsection 9, Code 2011, is amended
- 16 by striking the subsection.
- 17 Sec. 10. Section 35A.14, subsection 5, unnumbered paragraph
- 18 1, Code 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 19 The department commission shall adopt rules governing the
- 20 distribution of grants under this section in accordance with
- 21 the following:
- 22 Sec. 11. Section 35A.17, subsection 4, Code 2011, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- 4. The department commission shall adopt rules, pursuant
- 25 to chapter 17A, deemed necessary for the administration of the
- 26 county commission of veteran affairs training program.
- 27 Sec. 12. Section 36.8, Code 2011, is amended to read as
- 28 follows:
- 29 36.8 Rules.
- 30 The department commission shall adopt rules pursuant to
- 31 chapter 17A to implement this chapter.
- 32 Sec. 13. Section 36.9, Code 2011, is amended to read as
- 33 follows:
- 34 36.9 Appropriations.
- 35 This chapter shall be implemented by the department

- 1 commission each fiscal year that appropriations are made to the
- 2 department commission for the implementation.
- 3 EXPLANATION
- 4 This bill makes changes relative to the duties and
- 5 responsibilities of the department of veterans affairs and the
- 6 commission on veterans affairs. The bill requires that the
- 7 commission, upon review of rules proposed by the department,
- 8 approve such rules before adoption by the department.
- 9 The bill specifies that the commission may adopt rules for
- 10 the provision of training to county veteran affairs executive
- 11 directors and administrators. The bill requires that the
- 12 commission consult with the department on such rules. The bill
- 13 also requires the commission to provide certain recommendations
- 14 to the department during annual budget reviews and any changes
- 15 that occur during the fiscal year. The bill further specifies
- 16 that the commission may adopt rules related to veterans
- 17 bonus application procedures, investigations, approvals or
- 18 disapprovals, and payments.
- 19 The bill requires that the commission identify and report
- 20 to the legislature on the short and long-term goals of the
- 21 veterans trust fund, prior to any future appropriations by
- 22 the general assembly. The bill strikes emergency rulemaking
- 23 authority over the veterans trust fund.
- 24 The bill also shifts the authority to adopt rules over the
- 25 injured veterans grant program and the county commission of
- 26 veteran affairs training program to the commission from the
- 27 department.
- 28 The bill further shifts the authority to adopt rules to the
- 29 commission from the department for issues regarding medical
- 30 reporting requirements related to veterans exposed to chemicals
- 31 while serving in the armed forces.
- 32 The bill finally allows the department to propose
- 33 rules regarding policy for the management and operation
- 34 of the department to the commission for the commission's
- 35 consideration.
