HOUSE FILE 365 BY KLEIN

A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act providing for the home delivery of alcoholic beverages
- 2 by retailers.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

H.F. 365

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **123.46A** Delivery of alcoholic 2 beverages by retailers.
- Licensees and permittees authorized to sell alcoholic
- 4 liquor, wine, or beer in original unopened containers for
- 5 consumption off the licensed premises may deliver alcoholic
- 6 liquor, wine, or beer to a home or other designated location in
- 7 this state. Deliveries shall be limited to alcoholic beverages
- 8 authorized by the licensee's or permittee's license or permit.
- 9 2. All deliveries of alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer shall
- 10 be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:
- 11 a. Payment for the alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer shall be
- 12 received on the licensed premises at the time of order.
- 13 b. Alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer delivered to a person
- 14 shall be for personal use and not for resale.
- 15 c. Deliveries shall only be made to persons in this state
- 16 who are twenty-one years of age or older.
- 17 d. Deliveries shall not be made to a person who is
- 18 intoxicated or is simulating intoxication.
- 19 e. Deliveries shall occur during the hours in which
- 20 alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer may be lawfully sold.
- 21 f. Delivery of alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer shall be made
- 22 by the licensee or permittee, or the licensee's or permittee's
- 23 employee, and not by a third party.
- 24 g. Delivery personnel shall be eighteen years of age or
- 25 older.
- 26 h. Deliveries shall be made in a vehicle owned, leased, or
- 27 under the control of the licensee or permittee.
- 28 i. Valid proof of the recipient's identity and age shall
- 29 be obtained at the time of delivery, and the signature of a
- 30 person twenty-one years of age or older shall be obtained as a
- 31 condition of delivery.
- 32 j. Licensees and permittees shall maintain records
- 33 of deliveries which include the quantity delivered, the
- 34 recipient's name and address, and the signature of the
- 35 recipient of the alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer. The records

- 1 shall be maintained on the licensed premises for a period of 2 three years.
- 3 3. A violation of this section or any other provision of 4 this chapter shall subject the licensee or permittee to the 5 penalty provisions of section 123.39.
- 6 4. Nothing in this section shall impact the direct shipment 7 of wine as regulated by section 123.187.
- 8 EXPLANATION
- 9 This bill authorizes the home delivery of alcoholic 10 beverages by retailers.
- 11 The bill provides that a licensee or permittee authorized
- 12 to sell liquor, wine, or beer in original unopened containers
- 13 for consumption off the licensed premises may deliver it to a
- 14 home or other designated location in Iowa. Deliveries shall be
- 15 limited to alcoholic beverages authorized by the licensee's or
- 16 permittee's license or permit.
- 17 The bill states that deliveries shall be subject to several
- 18 requirements and restrictions. Specifically, payment for
- 19 the liquor, wine, or beer shall be received on the licensed
- 20 premises at the time of order; liquor, wine, or beer shall be
- 21 for personal use and not for resale; deliveries shall only
- 22 be made to persons in this state who are 21 or older; and
- 23 deliveries shall not be made to a person who is intoxicated or
- 24 is simulating intoxication. Additionally, deliveries shall
- 25 occur during the hours in which liquor, wine, or beer may be
- 26 lawfully sold and shall be made by the licensee or permittee,
- 27 or the licensee's or permittee's employee. Delivery personnel
- 28 are required to be 18 or older. Further, deliveries shall
- 29 be made in a vehicle owned, leased, or under the control of
- 30 the licensee or permittee, valid proof of the recipient's
- 31 identity and age shall be obtained at the time of delivery and
- 32 the signature of an adult shall be obtained as a condition
- 33 of delivery, and licensees and permittees are required to
- 34 maintain records of deliveries which include the quantity
- 35 delivered, recipient's name and address, and the signature of

- 1 the recipient of the liquor, wine, or beer.
- 2 The bill states that these records shall be maintained on
- 3 the licensed premises for a period of three years, and that
- 4 the bill's provisions do not impact provisions regulating the
- 5 direct shipment of wine in Code section 123.187.
- 6 The bill provides that a violation of the bill's provisions,
- 7 or any other provision of Code chapter 123, shall subject the
- 8 licensee's or permittee's license or permit to the penalty
- 9 provisions of Code section 123.39, which include possible
- 10 suspension or revocation and a civil penalty not to exceed
- 11 \$1,000 per violation.
