## A BILL FOR

1 An Act establishing the council for agricultural education. 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 256.32 Council for agricultural
2 education.

3 l. An advisory council for agricultural education is
4 established, which consists of nine members appointed by the
5 governor. The nine members shall include the following:

6 *a.* Five persons representing all areas of agriculture and7 diverse geographical areas.

8 b. The individual representing agriculture on the state9 council for vocational education.

10 c. A secondary school program instructor, a postsecondary 11 school program instructor, and a teacher educator.

12 2. The council may also include as ex officio members the 13 following persons, as determined by the voting members of the 14 council:

15 *a*. The state future farmers of America president.

16 b. The current state future farmers of America alumni 17 association president.

18 c. The current postsecondary agriculture students president.
19 d. The current young farmers educational association
20 president.

21 e. A state consultant in agricultural education.

f. The secretary of agriculture or the secretary's designee.
g. Two members of each house of the general assembly. This
membership shall be bipartisan in composition and one member
each shall be selected by the president of the senate, after
consultation with the majority leader of the senate, and by the
minority leader of the senate, and one member each shall be
selected by the speaker of the house of representatives and by
the minority leader of the house of representatives.

30 3. The duties of the council are to review, develop, 31 and recommend standards for secondary and postsecondary 32 agricultural education. The council shall annually issue a 33 report to the state board of education and the chairpersons 34 of the house and senate agriculture and education committees 35 regarding both short-term and long-term curricular standards

1 for agricultural education and the council's activities. The 2 council shall meet a minimum of twice annually, and must have 3 a quorum consisting of a majority of voting members present 4 to hold an official meeting and to take any final council 5 action. However, hearings may be held without a quorum. The 6 chairperson shall be elected annually by and from the voting 7 membership. The initial organizational meeting shall be called 8 by the director of the department of education.

9 4. The term of membership is three years. The terms shall 10 be staggered so that three of the terms end each year, but no 11 member serving on the initial council shall serve less than one 12 year. The governor shall determine the length of the initial 13 terms of office. However, the terms of office for members of 14 the general assembly shall be as provided in section 69.16B. 15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill establishes the council for agricultural education 17 as repealed by 2010 Acts, chapter 1031. The council shall 18 consist of nine voting members appointed by the governor 19 including five persons representing all areas of agriculture 20 and diverse geographical areas, the individual representing 21 agriculture on the state council for vocational education, a 22 secondary school program instructor, a postsecondary school 23 program instructor, and a teacher educator. The council 24 may also include as ex officio nonvoting members the state 25 future farmers of America president, the current state future 26 farmers of America alumni association president, the current 27 postsecondary agriculture students president, the current young 28 farmers educational association president, a state consultant 29 in agricultural education, the secretary of agriculture or 30 the secretary's designee, and two members of each house of 31 the general assembly. The bill provides that the legislative 32 members shall be bipartisan in composition and sets out 33 procedures for their appointment.

The bill sets out duties and procedures for the council, including reviewing, developing, and recommending standards for

1 secondary and postsecondary agricultural education and issuing 2 an annual report to the state board of education and the house 3 and senate agriculture and education committees. The term of 4 membership for the council is three years.
