## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the return of refund values to consumers for
- 2 empty beverage containers.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 445

- 1 Section 1. Section 455C.2, subsection 1, Code 2011, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 1. A refund value of not less than five cents shall be paid
- 4 by the consumer on each beverage container sold in this state
- 5 by a dealer for consumption off the premises. Upon return
- 6 of the empty beverage container upon which a refund value
- 7 has been paid to the dealer or person operating a redemption
- 8 center and acceptance of the empty beverage container by the
- 9 dealer or person operating a redemption center, the dealer or
- 10 person operating a redemption center shall return the amount
- 11 of the refund value to the consumer and the person operating a
- 12 redemption center shall pay a refund value to the consumer of
- 13 not less than four cents as determined by the person operating
- 14 a redemption center.
- 15 Sec. 2. Section 455C.5, subsection 1, Code 2011, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 1. Each beverage container sold or offered for sale in
- 18 this state by a dealer shall clearly indicate by embossing or
- 19 by a stamp, label, or other method securely affixed to the
- 20 container, the refund value of the container that must be paid
- 21 by the consumer. The department shall specify, by rule, the
- 22 minimum size of the refund value indication on the beverage
- 23 containers.
- 24 Sec. 3. Section 455C.6, subsection 1, Code 2011, is amended
- 25 to read as follows:
- 26 1. To facilitate the return of empty beverage containers
- 27 and to serve dealers of beverages, any person may establish a
- 28 redemption center, subject to the approval of the department,
- 29 at which consumers may return empty beverage containers and
- 30 receive payment of the refund value of such beverage containers
- 31 in an amount determined pursuant to section 455C.2, subsection
- 32 1, by the person operating the redemption center.
- 33 Sec. 4. Section 455C.7, Code 2011, is amended to read as
- 34 follows:
- 35 455C.7 Unapproved redemption centers.

## H.F. 445

- 1 Any person may establish a redemption center which has
- 2 not been approved by the department, at which a consumer may
- 3 return empty beverage containers and receive payment of the
- 4 refund value of the beverage containers in an amount determined
- 5 pursuant to section 455C.2, subsection 1, by the person
- 6 operating the redemption center. The establishment of an
- 7 unapproved redemption center shall not relieve any dealer from
- 8 the responsibility of redeeming any empty beverage containers
- 9 of the kind and brand sold by the dealer.
- 10 EXPLANATION
- 11 This bill relates to the return of refund values to consumers
- 12 for empty beverage containers.
- 13 The bill allows a person operating a redemption center to
- 14 determine the amount of refund value of not less than 4 cents
- 15 that may be paid to a consumer upon the return of an empty
- 16 beverage container. The bill provides that beverage containers
- 17 sold or offered for sale in this state must clearly indicate
- 18 the refund value of the container that must be paid by the
- 19 consumer.
