A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act providing for implementation of a local services
- 2 approach for addressing child foster care and associated
- 3 services provided outside this state.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. OUT-OF-STATE FOSTER CARE PLACEMENT LOCAL 2 SERVICES APPROACH.
- 3 l. For the purposes of this section, unless the context 4 otherwise requires:
- 5 a. "Department" means the department of human services.
- 6 b. "Foster care" means any out-of-home placement of a child
- 7 in accordance with a court order entered under chapter 232 or
- 8 by agreement with the department.
- 9 c. "Foster care placement outside of this state" means
- 10 a foster care placement to which all of the following
- 11 circumstances are applicable:
- 12 (1) The location of the placement is outside of this state.
- 13 (2) The cost of the placement and the services associated
- 14 with the placement exceed the maximum amount payable under this
- 15 state's reimbursement limitations for a child with similar
- 16 needs in a foster care placement and the services associated
- 17 with the placement in this state.
- 18 2. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, the
- 19 department shall implement a local services approach in
- 20 accordance with the section. In the local services approach,
- 21 if a child from an area is in a foster care placement outside of
- 22 this state or the department is considering recommending such a
- 23 placement for a child, the department shall provide foster care
- 24 providers in the area with an opportunity to provide a level
- 25 of services comparable to the level of services necessitating
- 26 the placement outside this state. Under the local services
- 27 approach, in lieu of the reimbursement limitations otherwise
- 28 applicable to the foster care placement and associated services
- 29 for the child in this state, the cost of the placement and the
- 30 services associated with the placement shall not exceed the
- 31 lower of the following amounts:
- 32 a. The cost of the foster care placement outside of this
- 33 state and the services associated with the placement.
- 34 b. The average cost of foster care placements outside this
- 35 state and the services associated with such placements during

1 the previous fiscal year.

- 2 3. The department shall provide progress reports on
- 3 the local services approach to the members of the joint
- 4 appropriations subcommittee on health and human services, other
- 5 interested legislators, and the legislative services agency
- 6 during the 2012 legislative session and shall submit a final
- 7 report by December 14, 2012.
- 8 EXPLANATION
- 9 This bill requires the department of human services to
- 10 implement a local services approach for addressing child foster
- ll care and associated services provided outside this state during
- 12 fiscal year 2011-2012.
- 13 The bill defines "foster care" to mean any out-of-home
- 14 placement of a child in accordance with a court order entered
- 15 under Code chapter 232 or by agreement with the department. A
- 16 foster care placement outside this state is one in which the
- 17 cost of the placement and the services associated with the
- 18 placement exceed the maximum amount payable under this state's
- 19 reimbursement limitations for a child with similar needs in
- 20 a foster care placement and the services associated with the
- 21 placement in this state.
- 22 In the local services approach, if a child from an area
- 23 is in a foster care placement outside of this state or the
- 24 department is considering recommending such a placement for
- 25 a child, the department is required to provide foster care
- 26 providers in the area with an opportunity to provide a level
- 27 of services comparable to the level of services necessitating
- 28 the placement outside this state. In lieu of the reimbursement
- 29 limitations otherwise applicable to the foster care placement
- 30 and associated services for the child in this state, the cost
- 31 of the services cannot exceed the lower of the following: the
- 32 cost of the foster care placement outside of this state and
- 33 the services associated with the placement or the average cost
- 34 of foster care placements outside this state and the services
- 35 associated with such placements during the previous fiscal

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- 1 year.
- 2 The department is required to provide progress reports
- 3 on the local services approach to the members of the joint
- 4 appropriations subcommittee on health and human services, other
- 5 interested legislators, and the legislative services agency
- 6 during the 2012 legislative session and to submit a final
- 7 report by December 14, 2012.
