HOUSE FILE 81 BY ISENHART and WILLEMS

A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the use of school district physical
- 2 plant and equipment levy revenue and statewide school
- 3 infrastructure funding.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 297.22, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code 1 2 2011, is amended to read as follows: The board of directors of a school district may sell, 3 a. 4 lease, exchange, give, or grant, and accept any interest 5 in real property to, with, or from a county, municipal 6 corporation, school district, community college for the purpose 7 specified in section 298.3, subsection 1, paragraph "n", 8 township, or area education agency if the real property is 9 within the jurisdiction of both the grantor and grantee. Sec. 2. Section 298.3, subsection 1, Code 2011, is amended 10 11 by adding the following new paragraph: 12 NEW PARAGRAPH. n. Notwithstanding the requirement that 13 a school district have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters 14 within the territory of the school district under section 15 274.1, joint infrastructure projects with one or more school 16 districts or one or more school districts and an Iowa community 17 college for buildings or facilities constructed or leased for 18 the purpose of offering classes under a district-to-community 19 college sharing agreement or concurrent enrollment program 20 that meets the requirements for funding under section 257.11, 21 subsection 3. Sec. 3. Section 423F.3, subsection 3, paragraph a, Code 22 23 2011, is amended to read as follows: 24 If the board of directors adopts a resolution to use a. 25 funds received under the operation of this chapter solely for 26 providing property tax relief by reducing indebtedness from 27 the levies specified under section 298.2 or 298.18 or for the 28 purpose specified in section 298.3, subsection 1, paragraph 29 "n'', the board of directors may approve a revenue purpose 30 statement for that purpose such purposes without submitting the 31 revenue purpose statement to a vote of the electors. 32 EXPLANATION 33 This bill authorizes the use of revenue from the regular 34 and voter-approved physical plant and equipment levies to be 35 expended for joint infrastructure projects with one or more

7 The bill authorizes the board of directors of a school 8 district, by resolution, to use local sales and services 9 tax revenue received under Code chapter 423F for joint 10 infrastructure projects with one or more school districts or 11 one or more school districts and an Iowa community college for 12 buildings or facilities constructed or leased for the purpose 13 of offering classes under a district-to-community college 14 sharing agreement or concurrent enrollment program that meets 15 the requirements for funding under Code section 257.11(3), 16 following approval of a revenue purpose statement, without 17 submitting the revenue purpose statement approving such use of 18 funds to a vote of the electors.

19 The bill adds community colleges to the list of entities 20 that a board of directors of a school district may sell, lease, 21 exchange, give, or grant, and accept any interest in real 22 property to, with, or from if the real property is within the 23 jurisdiction of both the grantor and grantee and it is for a 24 joint infrastructure project with one or more school districts 25 and an Iowa community college for buildings or facilities 26 constructed or leased for the purpose of offering classes under 27 a district-to-community college sharing agreement or concurrent 28 enrollment program that meets the requirements for funding 29 under Code section 257.11(3).
