## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act related to civil service employees by removing state
- 2 residency requirements and modifying a city's authority to
- 3 set distance or travel-based residency requirements.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 83

- 1 Section 1. Section 400.17, subsection 3, Code 2011, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 3. Employees shall not be required to be a resident of
- 4 the city in which they are employed, but they shall become
- 5 a resident of the state within two years of such appointment
- 6 or the date employment begins and shall remain a resident
- 7 of the state during the remainder of employment. However,
- 8 cities Cities may set a reasonable maximum distance outside
- 9 of the corporate limits of the city, or a reasonable maximum
- 10 travel time, that police officers, fire fighters, and other
- 11 critical municipal city employees may live from their place of
- 12 employment. Each employee residing outside the state on the
- 13 date of appointment or on the date employment begins shall take
- 14 reasonable steps to become a resident of the state as soon as
- 15 practicable following appointment or beginning of employment.
- 16 EXPLANATION
- 17 This bill relates to residency requirements for civil
- 18 service employees.
- 19 The bill removes the requirement that civil service
- 20 employees obtain state residency within two years of
- 21 appointment to a position with the city, and throughout
- 22 their employment. The bill further removes the requirement
- 23 that employees residing outside of the state take reasonable
- 24 actions to attain Iowa residency as soon as practicable after
- 25 appointment.
- 26 Current law allows a city to set distance and travel-time
- 27 limits for police, fire fighters, and other critical employees
- 28 who live outside the city. The bill expands this authority to
- 29 allow a city to set such limits for all nonresident employees.
