HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 4

- 1 A Resolution calling for the withdrawal of the state
- 2 of Iowa from the Midwestern Regional Greenhouse Gas
- 3 Reduction Accord.
- 4 WHEREAS, there has been no credible economic
- 5 analysis of the costs associated with carbon-reduction
- 6 mandates and the consequential effect of the increasing
- 7 costs of conducting business in this state; and
- 8 WHEREAS, forcing business, industry, and food
- 9 producers to reduce carbon emissions through government
- 10 mandates and cap-and-trade policies under consideration
- 11 for the regional climate initiative will increase the
- 12 cost of conducting business, push companies to conduct
- 13 business with other states or nations, and increase
- 14 consumer costs for electricity, fuel, and food; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the Congressional Budget Office warns that
- 16 the cost of cap-and-trade policies will be borne by
- 17 consumers and will place a disproportionately high
- 18 burden on poorer families; and
- 19 WHEREAS, simply reducing carbon emissions in
- 20 this state will not have a significant impact on
- 21 international carbon reduction, especially while
- 22 countries like China, Russia, Mexico, and India
- 23 emit an ever-increasing amount of carbon into the
- 24 atmosphere; and
- 25 WHEREAS, a tremendous amount of economic growth
- 26 would be sacrificed for a reduction in carbon emission
- 27 that would have no appreciable impact on global
- 28 concentrations of carbon dioxide; and

- 1 WHEREAS, no state or nation has enhanced economic
- 2 opportunities for its citizens or increased gross
- 3 domestic product through cap-and-trade or other carbon
- 4 reduction policies; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Europe's cap-and-trade system has been
- 6 undermined by political favoritism, and accounting
- 7 irregularities and has failed to achieve carbon
- 8 reduction targets; NOW THEREFORE,
- 9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, That
- 10 the House of Representatives urges the Governor to
- 11 withdraw the state of Iowa from the Midwestern Regional
- 12 Greenhouse Gas Reduction Accord; and
- 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That enrolled copies of
- 14 this Resolution shall be sent to the members of Iowa's
- 15 congressional delegation and the director of the
- 16 Midwestern Regional Greenhouse Gas Reduction Accord.
