## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 56

- 1 A Resolution to recognize the Trinity United Methodist
- 2 Church building in Des Moines on its centennial.
- 3 WHEREAS, for over a century Trinity United Methodist
- 4 Church has been a part of the Riverbend community of
- 5 Des Moines, acting as a witness for peace and social
- 6 justice and a haven for compassion, feeding both body
- 7 and soul of those in the community; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Trinity United has been a place of worship,
- 9 a place of Christian education, and a place where
- 10 diverse people are surrounded by a community of love
- 11 and are sent out into the world to put their faith into
- 12 action; and
- WHEREAS, Trinity United embraces three ministries,
- 14 including the Trinity United Methodist Church, Las
- 15 Americas Communidad de Fe, and Children and Family
- 16 Urban Ministries; and
- 17 WHEREAS, these three ministries offer a variety of
- 18 community programs, including a prison ministry and an
- 19 English-as-a-second-language program; and
- 20 WHEREAS, feeding both the body and soul is most
- 21 evident in the daily work of these ministries, where
- 22 every day some 300 people come through the doors,
- 23 some for a before-school breakfast or an after-school
- 24 program for children and youth, some to learn English,
- 25 some to attend a citizenship class, and some to simply
- 26 get a wholesome meal in these hard times where the
- 27 daily free supper which normally serves around 120
- 28 persons now serves as many as 170 persons; and
