- 1 An Act relating to interment rights of certain veterans
- 2 and their spouses in cemeteries owned and controlled by
- 3 governmental subdivisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 523I.304, subsection 7, Code 2011, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 7. A cemetery owned and controlled by a governmental
- 4 subdivision shall adopt and enforce a rule allowing any
- 5 veteran who is a landowner or who lives within the governmental
- 6 subdivision to purchase an interment space and to be interred
- 7 within the cemetery. The rule shall also allow any veteran who
- 8 purchases an interment space within the cemetery to purchase an
- 9 interment space for interment of the spouse of the veteran and
- 10 shall allow the surviving spouse of a veteran interred within
- 11 the cemetery to purchase an interment space and be interred
- 12 within the cemetery. For the purposes of this section,
- 13 "veteran" means the same as defined in section 35.1.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- 15 This bill requires that a governmental subdivision allow a
- 16 veteran who purchases an interment space in a cemetery owned
- 17 and controlled by the governmental subdivision to purchase
- 18 space for the veteran's spouse and for the spouse to be
- 19 interred in the cemetery. The bill also allows the spouse of
- 20 a veteran already interred within such a cemetery to purchase
- 21 interment space for the spouse and for the spouse to be
- 22 interred in that cemetery. Current law only allows a veteran
- 23 to purchase an interment space for the veteran and for only the
- 24 veteran to be interred within the cemetery.
