## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to eligibility of older children for the
- 2 statewide preschool program for four-year-old children.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 256C.3, subsection 1, Code 2011, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 l. Eligible children. A child who is a resident of Iowa and
- 4 is four years of age on or before September 15 of a school year
- 5 shall be eligible to enroll in the preschool program under this
- 6 chapter. If space and funding are available, a school district
- 7 approved to participate in the preschool program may enroll a
- 8 younger or older child in the preschool program; however, the  $\underline{a}$
- 9 younger child shall not be counted for state funding purposes.
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 256C.4, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code
- 11 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 a. To be included as an eligible student in the enrollment
- 13 count of the preschool programming provided by a school
- 14 district approved to participate in the preschool program, a
- 15 child must be at least four years of age by September 15 in the
- 16 base year and attending the school district's approved local
- 17 program.
- 18 EXPLANATION
- 19 This bill relates to eligibility of older children for the
- 20 statewide preschool program for four-year-old children. Under
- 21 current law, the program allows enrollment of a child who is
- 22 younger or older than four years of age by September 15 if
- 23 space and funding are available. However, the younger or older
- 24 child cannot be counted for state funding purposes.
- The bill amends Code section 256C.3, relating to eligibility
- 26 for the program, and Code section 256C.4, relating to funding
- 27 provisions and enrollment, to allow a child older than
- 28 four years of age to be counted for state funding purposes.
- 29 Existing law in Code section 256C.4 prohibits a student
- 30 included in the enrollment count under the state foundation aid
- 31 formula determined under Code section 257.6 to also be included
- 32 in the enrollment count for the preschool program.
