## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act eliminating the transfer tax imposed on insurers
- 2 organized in other states who elect to become domestic
- 3 insurers in Iowa.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## S.F. 109

Section 1. Section 508.12, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1 2 2011, is amended to read as follows: An insurer which is organized under the laws of any state and 3 4 has created or will create jobs in this state or which is an 5 affiliate or subsidiary of a domestic insurer, and is admitted 6 to do business in this state for the purpose of writing 7 insurance authorized by this chapter may become a domestic 8 insurer by complying with section 490.902 or 491.33 and with 9 all of the requirements of law relative to the organization 10 and licensing of a domestic insurer of the same type and by 11 designating its principal place of business in this state, and, 12 upon payment to the commissioner of insurance of a transfer 13 tax in a sum equal to twenty-five percent of the premium tax 14 paid pursuant to the provisions of chapter 432 for the last 15 calendar year immediately preceding its becoming a domestic 16 corporation or the sum of ten thousand dollars, whichever is 17 the lesser but not less than one thousand dollars, may become a 18 domestic corporation and be entitled to like certificates of 19 its corporate existence and license to transact business in 20 this state, and be subject in all respects to the authority and 21 jurisdiction thereof. Sec. 2. Section 515.78, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 22 23 2011, is amended to read as follows: 24 An insurer which is organized under the laws of any state and 25 has created or will create jobs in this state or which is an 26 affiliate or subsidiary of a domestic insurer, and is admitted 27 to do business in this state for the purpose of writing 28 insurance authorized by this chapter may become a domestic 29 insurer by complying with section 490.902 or 491.33 and with 30 all of the requirements of law relative to the organization 31 and licensing of a domestic insurer of the same type and by 32 designating its principal place of business in this state, and, 33 upon payment to the commissioner of insurance of a transfer 34 tax in a sum equal to twenty-five percent of the premium tax 35 paid pursuant to the provisions of chapter 432 for the last
