A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act providing for the delivery of a written communication by
- 2 a drainage or levee district.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.F. 147

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **468.221 Written communication** 2 delivered to the state or a local government.
- 3 1. This section applies whenever a board or county officer
- 4 acting under this chapter is required to deliver a written
- 5 communication to a state agency or local government. The
- 6 written communication includes but is not limited to a notice,
- 7 service of process, demand, statement, or a report.
- 8 2. The board or county officer may deliver the written
- 9 communication to any of the following:
- 10 a. For delivery to a state agency, to the administrative
- 11 head of the state agency or its governing body. The written
- 12 communication may also be delivered to a person designated by
- 13 the administrative head of the state agency or its governing
- 14 body. The written communication may be delivered to the
- 15 executive council if the administrative head of the state
- 16 government or its governing body cannot be determined.
- 17 b. For delivery to a local government, to the governing body
- 18 of the local government. The written communication may also
- 19 be delivered to a person designated by the governing body. As
- 20 used in this paragraph, "local government" includes a county,
- 21 city, township, or any special purpose district or authority.
- 22 EXPLANATION
- 23 RECOMMENDATION. This bill is based on a recommendation of
- 24 the levee and drainage district law study committee which met
- 25 in 2010.
- 26 LEVEE AND DRAINAGE DISTRICTS. The bill addresses levee and
- 27 drainage districts organized under Code chapter 468 and which
- 28 authorizes the removal of excess precipitation accumulating
- 29 on land and protecting land from surface water flooding. A
- 30 district is managed by a "board" which is the county board of
- 31 supervisors for a district established in one county, the joint
- 32 boards of supervisors in a district which crosses county lines
- 33 (intercounty districts), or by the district's landowners acting
- 34 through an elected board of trustees (Code Section 468.3(2)).
- 35 DELIVERY OF WRITTEN COMMUNICATION. The bill applies when

- 1 a board or county officer is required to deliver a written
- 2 communication to a state agency or local government. Under
- 3 the bill, the written communication may be delivered to the
- 4 administrative head of the agency or its governing body or to
- 5 a person designated by the administrative head or governing
- 6 body or alternatively to the executive council. The bill also
- 7 provides that written communication may be delivered to the
- 8 local government's governing body or to a person designated by
- 9 the governing body.
