A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act requiring that the director of the Iowa law enforcement
- 2 academy be appointed by the governor for a four-year term
- 3 from nominees selected by the law enforcement academy
- 4 council and including applicability provisions.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 80B.5, Code 2011, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 80B.5 Administration.
- 4 The administration of this chapter shall be vested in the
- 5 office of the governor. A director of the academy and such
- 6 shall be appointed by the governor from a slate of nominees
- 7 submitted to the governor by the Iowa law enforcement academy
- 8 council. The council shall submit a slate of up to three
- 9 nominees for the position to the governor for the governor's
- 10 consideration. The nominees shall be chosen by the affirmative
- 11 vote of a majority of council members upon the basis of their
- 12 qualifications and without regard to political affiliation.
- 13 The slate of nominees may include the current director. The
- 14 director shall serve for a four-year term beginning on January
- 15 l of an even-numbered year in which a general election for the
- 16 office of governor will not take place. A vacancy in this
- 17 position shall be filled in the same manner as the original
- 18 appointee. An appointee filling a vacancy shall serve for
- 19 the remainder of the original term. Other staff as may be
- 20 necessary for it the academy to function shall be employed
- 21 pursuant to the Iowa merit system provisions of chapter 8A,
- 22 subchapter IV.
- 23 Sec. 2. POSITION ABOLISHED. The position of the director
- 24 of the Iowa law enforcement academy, subject to the merit
- 25 system provisions of chapter 8A, subchapter IV, is abolished on
- 26 December 31, 2011.
- 27 Sec. 3. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to the appointment
- 28 of the director of the Iowa law enforcement academy for terms
- 29 beginning on or after January 1, 2012.
- 30 EXPLANATION
- 31 Current law provides that the position of director of the
- 32 Iowa law enforcement academy is a state merit system position.
- 33 This bill provides that the director is appointed by the
- 34 governor from a slate of up to three nominees submitted by
- 35 the Iowa law enforcement academy council. The bill provides

- 1 that nominees be chosen by the affirmative vote of a majority
- 2 of council members based on their qualifications and without
- 3 regard to political affiliation. The bill provides that the
- 4 council may include the current director in the slate of
- 5 nominees. The bill provides that the director serves for a
- 6 four-year term starting on January 1 in each even-numbered year
- 7 in which a general election for the office of governor will not
- 8 take place. The bill provides that a vacancy in the position
- 9 be filled in the same manner as the original appointee, with
- 10 the new appointee serving for the remainder of the original
- 11 term.
- 12 The bill abolishes the merit position of the director of the
- 13 Iowa law enforcement academy on December 31, 2011.
- 14 The bill applies to the appointment of the director of the
- 15 Iowa law enforcement academy for terms beginning on or after
- 16 January 1, 2012.
