A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to entitling mental health counselors to

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 249A.15A, Code 2011, is amended to read 2 as follows:
- 3 249A.15A Licensed marital and family therapists and, licensed
- 4 master social workers, and licensed mental health counselors.
- 5 l. The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
- 6 17A entitling marital and family therapists who are licensed
- 7 pursuant to chapter 154D to payment for behavioral health
- 8 services provided to recipients of medical assistance, subject
- 9 to limitations and exclusions the department finds necessary on
- 10 the basis of federal laws and regulations.
- 11 2. The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
- 12 17A entitling master social workers who hold a master's
- 13 degree approved by the board of social work, are licensed as
- 14 a master social worker pursuant to section 154C.3, subsection
- 15 1, paragraph "b", and provide treatment services under the
- 16 supervision of an independent social worker licensed pursuant
- 17 to section 154C.3, subsection 1, paragraph "c", to payment
- 18 for behavioral health services provided to recipients of
- 19 medical assistance, subject to limitations and exclusions the
- 20 department finds necessary on the basis of federal laws and
- 21 regulations.
- 3. The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A
- 23 entitling mental health counselors who are licensed pursuant to
- 24 chapter 154D to payment for behavioral health services provided
- 25 to recipients of medical assistance, subject to limitations
- 26 and exclusions the department finds necessary on the basis of
- 27 federal laws and regulations.
- 28 Sec. 2. MEDICAL ASSISTANCE STATE PLAN MENTAL HEALTH
- 29 COUNSELORS. The department of human services shall amend the
- 30 medical assistance state plan to allow mental health counselors
- 31 licensed in the state to be participating behavioral health
- 32 providers under the medical assistance program.
- 33 EXPLANATION
- 34 This bill directs the department of human services (DHS)
- 35 to adopt rules entitling licensed mental health counselors to

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- 1 payment for behavioral health services provided to recipients
- 2 of medical assistance, subject to limitations and exclusions
- 3 the department finds necessary on the basis of federal laws and
- 4 regulations. The bill also directs DHS to amend the Medicaid
- 5 state plan to allow licensed mental health counselors to be
- 6 participating behavioral health providers under the Medicaid
- 7 program.
