 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 257.8, subsection 2, Code 2011, is
2 amended to read as follows:

2. Categorical state percent of growth. The categorical 3 4 state percent of growth for the budget year beginning July 1, 5 2010, is two percent. The categorical state percent of growth 6 for the budget year beginning July 1, 2011, is two percent. 7 The categorical state percent of growth for each budget year 8 shall be established by statute which shall be enacted within 9 thirty days of the submission in the year preceding the 10 base year of the governor's budget under section 8.21. The 11 establishment of the categorical state percent of growth for a 12 budget year shall be the only subject matter of the bill which 13 enacts the categorical state percent of growth for a budget The categorical state percent of growth may include 14 year. 15 state percents of growth for the teacher salary supplement, the 16 professional development supplement, and the early intervention 17 supplement.

18 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT AND APPLICABILITY. This 19 Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon 20 enactment and is applicable for computing state aid under the 21 state school foundation program for the school budget year 22 beginning July 1, 2011.

EXPLANATION

This bill establishes a categorical state percent of growth of 2 percent for purposes of the state school foundation program for the school budget year beginning July 1, 2011. The categorical state percent of growth includes the teacher salary supplement, the professional development supplement, and the early intervention supplement. The bill takes effect upon enactment and is applicable for computing state aid under the state school foundation program for the school budget year beginning July 1, 2011.
